His primary focus however has been on Climate Finance. The Roofs to Reefs Programme has been the flagship programme that has led to the realisation of a number of innovative climate finance initiatives for Barbados including Debt Swaps, Policy-Based Loans (PBLs), the Blue Green Bank and the Barbados Contingent Credit Facility.
