

## Brazil- Transparency

Having as reference the country's third biennial update report to the Convention (BUR3), it is worth highlighting the need to ensure resources for the reports under the Convention and the Paris Agreement and for systems of measurement, reporting and verification of mitigation actions in developing countries. It is crucial as well to ensure resources to promote research, technological development and adequate infrastructure in key sectors of the economy and actions that leverage the adoption of low carbon technologies in such sectors. We shall highlight the need for greater investment in the development and dissemination of methodologies that can quantify the reduction of emissions from ongoing mitigation actions.

Financing guarantees must be provided for the implementation of the technological action plans resulting from the Technological Assessment Reports (TNAs) and for pilot projects in developing countries, as well as for future updates of the documents that highlight the priorities of the developing countries for mitigation and adaptation, including climate technologies. It is important to understand the demand for resources to promote the continuous training of national entities designated for the UNFCCC technology mechanism and the necessary support to the development of the activities for which they were assigned.

Finally, we recommend that an additional period may be requested by one country for sending the complementary information requested during the review process of BURs, since it requires internal articulation to reflect on the national needs to be highlighted.
