The session was given 35mins for completion. As part of a time management strategy, the GRCB process was broken down into 3 phases or three small chunks. This was done with the intention of working through at least one phase as demonstration. The three phases identified were:

- i) Gender analysis
- ii) Programme formulation
- iii) Costing

Starting with gender analysis, as a prompt the group was provided with a matrix (see table below) and instructed to consider the various stages of gender analysis and the institutional capacity, expertise and partnerships required to carry out gender analysis.
