Corrigendum to Comments of Liechtenstein to the preliminary findings of the Enforcement Branch of the Compliance Committee of the UNFCCC

Dear members and alternate members of the enforcement branch

In reference to the comments we shared regarding the adoption of a decision on preliminary findings and the preliminary finding on questions of implementation, we would like to herewith share the following correction:

In our letter addressed to the UNFCCC Compliance Committee on 20^{th} of December 2024, a typographical error was made. The number of Kyoto Protocol units which were not retired during the second commitment period as required is 1 558 777 t CO2 eq.

In our letter, a digit was missing. We regret this oversight and would appreciate if you could use the figure of 1 558 777 t CO2 eq, which aligns with the amount of total GHG emissions from sources included in Annex A to the Kyoto Protocol in the second commitment period for Liechtenstein, as stated in the report on the review of the report upon expiration of the additional period for fulfilling commitments for the second commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol of Liechtenstein submitted in 2023.¹ Liechtenstein restates that at the end of the additional period for fulfilling commitments (the "true up period"), Kyoto Protocol units in excess of 1 558 777 t CO2 eq were available for retirement in the national registry.
