Report on the meeting

1. Opening of the meeting

1. Ms. Veronica Jakarasi, co-chairperson of the plenary of the Committee, declared the twenty-sixth meeting of the plenary open on 4 July 2024. Ms. Veronica Jakarasi and her co-chair Mr. Arne Riedel welcomed the members and alternate members of the Committee to the meeting. The list of members and alternate members present at the meeting is contained in the annex to this report.
2. Ms. Jakarasi chaired agenda items 1 to 4 and 6 to 7 and Mr. Riedel chaired agenda items 5 and 8 to 12.
3. The secretariat provided information on participation and quorum. The secretariat confirmed that there was a quorum for the meeting and informed the plenary that a live broadcast link to the meeting had been posted on the UNFCCC website, where a recording of the meeting would also be available.

4. The plenary adopted the provisional agenda without changes ([CC/26/2024/1](#)) and agreed to conduct its work as presented by the chairperson in the indicative schedule of the meeting.

6. The plenary took note of the oral report of the enforcement branch, containing the outcomes of the branch's thirty-ninth meeting ([CC/EB/39/2024/2](#)), made by Mr. Arne Riedel, in his capacity as chairperson of the branch.

7. The plenary took note of the oral report of the facilitative branch, containing the outcomes of the branch's twenty-seventh meeting ([CC/FB/27/2024/2](#)), made by Ms. Veronica Jakarasi, in her capacity as chairperson of the branch.

**6. Information on the status of reports of expert review teams under
Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol**

8. The plenary noted the information provided by the secretariat on the status of submission and review of reports under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol (document [CC/26/2024/2](#)).

9. The plenary noted that, following the entry into force of the Doha Amendment on 31 December 2020, it will continue its work in response to the mandates in decisions 27/CMP.1 and 8/CMP.8 as well as Articles 7–8 of the Kyoto Protocol with respect to implementation of the Kyoto Protocol in the second commitment period, and consider questions of implementation arising from the review of the reports upon expiration of the additional period for fulfilling commitments for the second commitment period.

7. Consideration of gender and Action for Climate Empowerment (ACE) matters

10. The plenary took note of the presentation on gender and Action for Climate Empowerment made at its 26th meeting by the Communications and Engagement division of the secretariat. Furthermore, the plenary considered how it could contribute to reaching the Action for Climate Empowerment goal of empowering all members of society to engage in climate action through the six Action for Climate Empowerment elements of education, public awareness, training, public participation, public access to information and international cooperation. The plenary expresses its hope that Parties will keep in mind the goal of gender balance when submitting nominations for membership.

11. The plenary reviewed the draft of the annual report of the Compliance Committee to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) prepared by the bureau and adopted it ([FCCC/KP/CMP/2024/2](#)).

12. The plenary agreed to have the meetings of the enforcement and facilitative branches in conjunction with the plenary, in a hybrid setting, the second half of the year 2025 and requested the bureau, with the assistance of the secretariat, to identify an appropriate date and to start planning the next plenary and branch meetings.
