

# Global Implementation Accelerator



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# A cooperative, facilitative and voluntary initiative

Through the Global *Mutirão* decision adopted at COP30, Parties agreed to launch the Global Implementation Accelerator as a cooperative, facilitative and voluntary initiative, under the guidance of the COP30 and COP31 Presidencies



*Brazil, Türkiye and Australia are jointly designing the Accelerator*

# What is, at this stage, the proposal for what the Accelerator should be?

*The Accelerator should be a mechanism to accelerate solutions from the Action Agenda with the highest potential to trigger positive tipping points, producing potential global cascading effects*

# What would it accelerate?

It would accelerate the solutions (not individual projects) —

such as **technologies, procedures, and methodologies** —  
included in Plans to Accelerate Solutions (PAS) in the  
different initiatives and goals of the Action Agenda

# Will the Accelerator be limited to the existing pool of PAS in the Action Agenda?

No, the 5-year plan of the Action Agenda agreed at COP30 considers that new PAS will be presented in an ongoing manner, and all PAS will be considered for the Accelerator

*The Accelerator also aims to stimulate new PAS – strengthening, therefore, the Action Agenda*

# How will the solutions be selected from the Action Agenda pool of initiatives?

*The solutions will be assessed against a set of criteria that will be developed by the Presidencies. These may include, for example:*

- Reducing GHG concentration and strengthening resilience
- Urgency of impact on climate change
- Potential exponentiality and cascading
- NDCs / NAPs relevance
- Sequencing and maturity of the solutions
- Developing countries engagement
- Socioeconomic benefits

## **Independent group of experts**

An independent group of experts will select the ten to fifteen solutions that best respond to the criteria

## **Board review**

These solutions would then be sent to a Board that would make the final decision on the selection of around 3 to 5 solutions per year to be accelerated

# Who would be part of the Board?

*The board could include representatives from COP presidencies / High Level Champions, UNFCCC Secretariat, multilateral and development banks, and vertical funds*

*This is still under discussion among the presidencies*

**Most importantly, the Accelerator should be a permanent body that would complement the Action Agenda of individual presidencies**

# What would happen to the chosen solutions?

*The solutions would be accelerated through:*

## **Articulation of actors**

The articulation of actors able to give political prioritization to the solutions in key institutions, such as multilateral development banks, businesses, investors, philanthropy, technology companies, academia, national and subnational governments, among others

## **Combination of solutions and/or tools**

The combination of solutions and/or tools, such as existing financial instruments for reducing the cost of capital (for example, green bonds, FX hedging), global auctions for climate technologies, debt-for-climate swaps, digital public infrastructure, AI, technical assistance for capacity-building networks, among others

## Will the Accelerator support NDCs and NAPs implementation?

*Yes, it will help implement NDCs and NAPs since the solutions within the Action Agenda are part of NDCs and NAPs*

# How will the Accelerator work with other implementation mechanisms?

## COMPLEMENTARITY

The Accelerator aims to be complementary to the many other fundamental mechanisms in the implementation ecosystem

## ITS ADDED VALUE

Its added-value is that it will focus exclusively on solutions that have the potential to scale and produce cascading effects globally with high-impact exponential technologies

*A mechanism, operated in link with the Accelerator, is also being developed under the COP31 Action Agenda with the aim of supporting bringing on-ground actions and finance together*
