Article 6 of the Paris Agreement



Article 6.2 “Cooperative Approaches”

Article 6.2- Direct trading of Internationally Transferred Mitigation Outcomes (ITMOs)

Between countries, generally through bilateral or plurilateral agreements, with flexibility to define the cooperative approach.

Eligible Sectors: Any mitigation activity across all sectors may generate emission reductions and removals.

Article 6.4 “The Mechanism”

Article 6.4-Paris Agreement Crediting Mechanism (PACM)

The UNFCCC-centralized market mechanism shall:

- Promote GHG mitigation while fostering sustainable development.
- Incentivize participation by public and private entities authorized by the host Party.
- Contribute to emission reductions in the host Party, which can also be used by other Parties toward their NDCs.
- Deliver overall mitigation in global emissions.

Eligible Sectors: Any mitigation activity can generate A6.4 emission reductions and removals. It must be considered and approved by the host Party.

Article 6.8 “Non-Market Approaches”

Article 6.8-non-market approach

UNFCCC platform voluntarily used to facilitate matching projects with financial and technical support available in several focus areas (mitigation, adaptation and resilience and renewable energy).

- Transition request submission by 31 December 2023.
- Host Party approval submission by 31 December 2025.



The deadline for submission of a request for transition to the Article 6.4 mechanism is **31 December 2025**.



CASE 2: Activities applying an A6.4 Methodology.

Key actions:

- Revise the PDD using the A6.4 Mechanism templates.
- Request DOE validation to confirm:
 - ✓ Correct application of the A6.4 Methodology;
 - ✓ Compliance with all additional registration requirements;
- If validation is positive, the DOE must submit to the Secretariat:
 - ✓ The revised PPD and the validation report.

Deadline: Within one year after the publication of the Host Party's approval of transition or the availability of the new methodology, whichever occurs later.
