Statement by the Chair of the Consultative Group of Experts

- Thank you, Madame Chair.
- On behalf of the Consultative Group of Experts (CGE), I have the honor to report to the SBI on its work.
- In 2020, the CGE formulated its vision, mission and strategic objectives to guide its work, keeping the long-term needs and priorities of developing countries, as they implement the existing MRV arrangements under the Convention and to prepare for transitioning to the ETF under the Paris Agreement.
- The CGE using innovative approaches and methods successfully implemented its workplans for 2020 and 2021.
- This resulted in:
  - Training 609 national experts through 14 virtual regional handson training workshops;
  - Reaching 709 experts, through webinars on key thematic issues;
  - Developing, translating and disseminating online training resources, which included animation videos, technical handbooks, and hands-on exercises;
  - Continuing the training programme on the technical analysis of BURs;

- Increasing awareness of CGE activities through special events, informal forums, and online platforms;
- Compiling and summarizing capacity-building needs for the preparation of NCs and BURs.
- The CGE is fully committed to assisting developing countries on their important journey to implement the MRV arrangements and use that as a foundation for the ETF.
- In closing, the CGE looks forward to a successful review and revision of the terms of reference.
