Introduction

- Decision-making support tools are essential to grasp the extent and depth of climate change impacts on our society.
- They do so by providing a validated and predictable analytical framework to transform data into meaningful and comparable information that can be used as a critical input to the process of decision-making.
- For example, they can assist in energy-planning decision-making by:
 - Modelling national energy systems;
 - Assessing the GHG emissions associated with these systems;
 - Creating and comparing alternative baseline and mitigation scenarios;
 - And assessing the costs and benefits of alternative policies and measures.
- LEAP is user-friendly and free tool for integrated resource planning and greenhouse gas mitigation assessment. It can be used at the city, state, national, regional or global scale.
- This webinar covers LEAP as a tool you may find useful to your work.



Accessing UNFCCC tools and training materials

The CGE has developed training materials, regularly conducts webinars and workshops and collaborates with various development partners in order to support developing countries in improving their technical capacity to take climate action and report on them through the national communications and Biennial Update Reports.

Aspects such as identifying mitigation scenarios and the policy and regulatory decisions each scenario requires in order to translate them into mitigation actions to achieve emission reduction goals are regularly discussed in CGE workshops.
