Dear Executive Secretary,

In decision 1/CMA.7, "Global Mutirão: Uniting humanity in a global mobilization against climate change", the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement decided to establish a two-year work programme on climate finance, including on Article 9, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement in the context of Article 9 of the Paris Agreement as a whole.

Pursuant to paragraph 55 of decision 1/CMA.7, and in consultation with the respective constituencies, I appointed two co-chairs, one from a developed country and one from a developing country, to facilitate the work programme. In my letter to the co-chairs, I also encouraged them to prepare a workplan, with inputs from Parties and stakeholders, in order to provide predictability and clarity, and to reflect the outcomes of this engagement on a dedicated page on the UNFCCC website.

Parties and non-Party stakeholders have been engaging since 23 March 2026 through a call for submissions, virtual consultations and the engagement workshops held during the sixty-fourth sessions of the subsidiary bodies, where, among other matters, views were exchanged on the scope and modalities of the work programme.

As the work programme falls under the authority of the CMA, I request that the secretariat include the following sub-item under the item "Matters relating to finance" on the provisional agenda of CMA8 and CMA9 to allow Parties to consider their work under the programme as they deem appropriate:

*"Work programme on climate finance, including on Article 9, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement in the context of Article 9 of the Paris Agreement as a whole."*¹
