60 min	Open dialogue on Just Transition in the context of the IPCC Special Report on Global Warming of 1.5 °C
	<p>Purpose:</p> <p>We have all agreed in Paris to hold the increase in the global average temperature to well below 2 °C and pursuing efforts to limit to 1.5 °C. The recently published IPCC Special Report on Global Warming of 1.5 °C (SR1.5) highlights that a rapid and unprecedentedly far-reaching transition of the economy is required for any pathway limiting global warming to 1.5°C. At the same time, in Paris we have decided to take into account the imperative for the need for a just transition of the workforce and the creation of decent work and quality jobs. In this context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What does Just Transition mean for different stakeholders?• How can Just Transition policies contribute to the long-term goal of the Paris Agreement?• For which of the recommendations of the SR1.5 will the imperative of a just transition of the workforce be particularly relevant?• How can different stakeholders contribute to these policies?• Can we identify common areas among different constituencies and stakeholders that helps to achieve a Just Transition?
