Millions of people are newly displaced each year as a result of disasters linked to weather- and climate-related natural hazards. COP24 welcomed the recommendations developed under the first phase of the WIM Task Force on Displacement on integrated approaches to avert, minimize and address displacement related to the adverse impacts of climate change.

This event marks the launch of the second phase of the Task Force on Displacement, presents the new Plan of Action, and shows the significance of the recommendations welcomed by COP24 and how they can lead to solutions to some of the key challenges of displacement related to the adverse effects of climate change.

The event will showcase artwork and include a segment with the Winner of the 2019 COAL (Coalition for Art and Sustainable Development) Prize. This year's edition of the Prize called artists from around the world to address displacement related to disasters and climate change through their art.
