







Blue Zone

The Blue Zone is a UNFCCC-managed site, open to accredited party and observer delegates and media representatives.



Arrival at the Blue Zone (motorcade provided): 3 cars including an armoured vehicle for the VVIP






Entrance to the Blue Zone: VVIP + Entourage (3) + LO + Foreign Close Protection



International Travel

Heydar Aliyev International Airport has a total of four terminals and two runways.

- Two of the terminals are designated for general passenger use
- One terminal is for Heads of State and Heads of Government guests
- One terminal is for business executives flying to Baku



Domestic Travel

Accredited delegates are eligible to use public buses, metro and railway services to travel across the city free of charge alongside dedicated event shuttles throughout the Conference period.

24-Hour Service: Both airport and transfer services will operate round the clock to accommodate the influx of visitors.



Venue Transportation Infrastructure

- Parking Facilities: Large parking areas near the stadium
- Transport Connections: Proximity to a transport hub, offering a railway and metro station, and the intersection of four major roads connecting the stadium with the city centre and suburbs
- Dedicated Transport Hub: In addition to the existing transport hub, a dedicated bus hub will be set up close to the conference venue to provide the option of a faster, seamless journey for all COP29 accredited visitors




