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Key Discussion Points

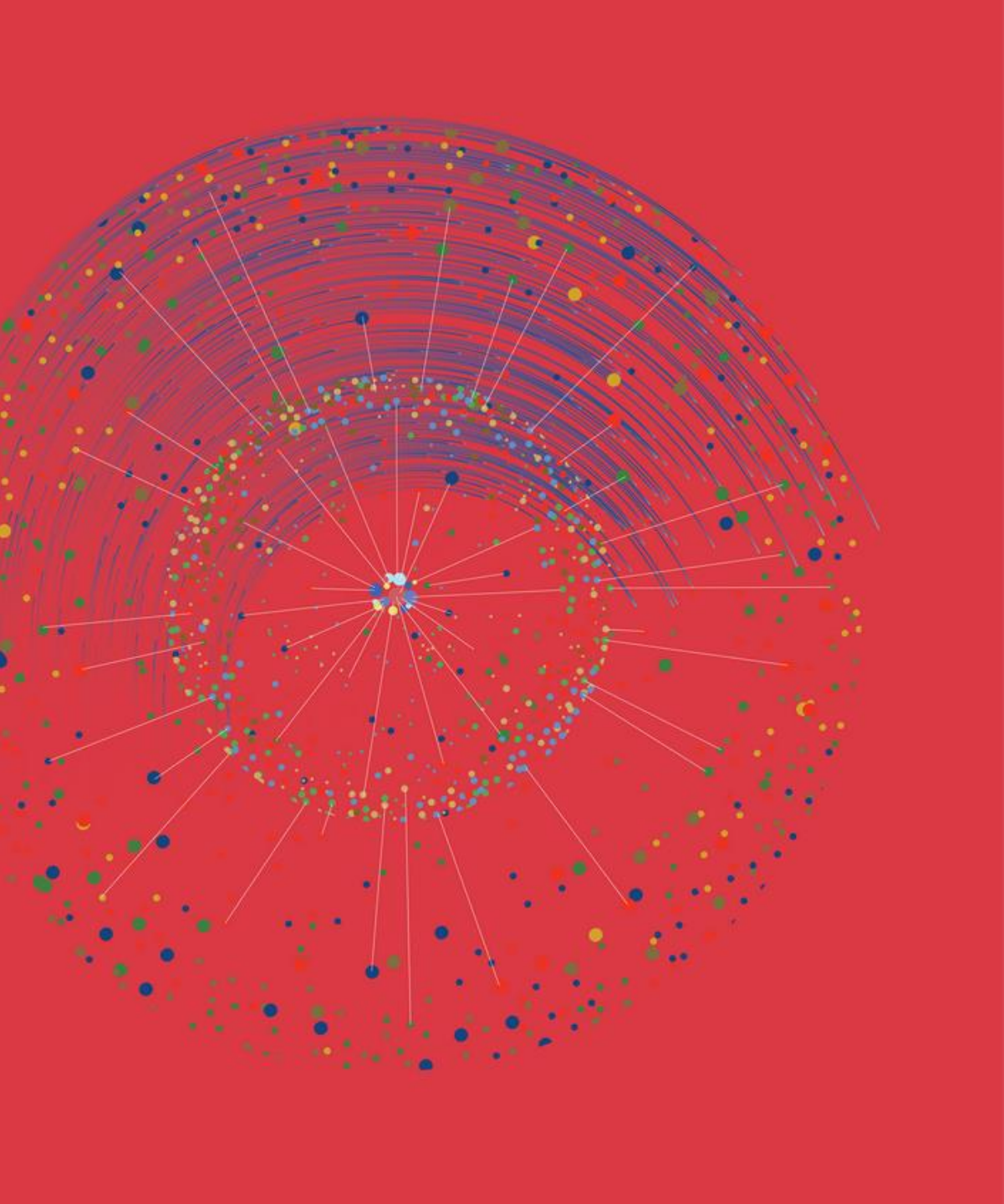
- Strengthen national/regional data mechanisms to better support NDC development and progress tracking.
- Address gaps in tech adoption and project execution across energy, transport, and agriculture to support effective NDC implementation.
- Societal resistance to change hampers the adoption of sustainable practices due to perceived risks and competing priorities.



Key Discussion Points

- Political inconsistency across changing administrations disrupts long-term climate initiatives and affects project continuity.
- Strengthening enabling environments through supportive policies and regulations is essential for effective NDC implementation.
- There is a need to leverage a mix of traditional funding (e.g. GEF, GCF, Adaptation Fund, etc.) and innovative financial mechanisms (e.g. green bonds, carbon markets, PPPs, etc.) to support NDC implementation.

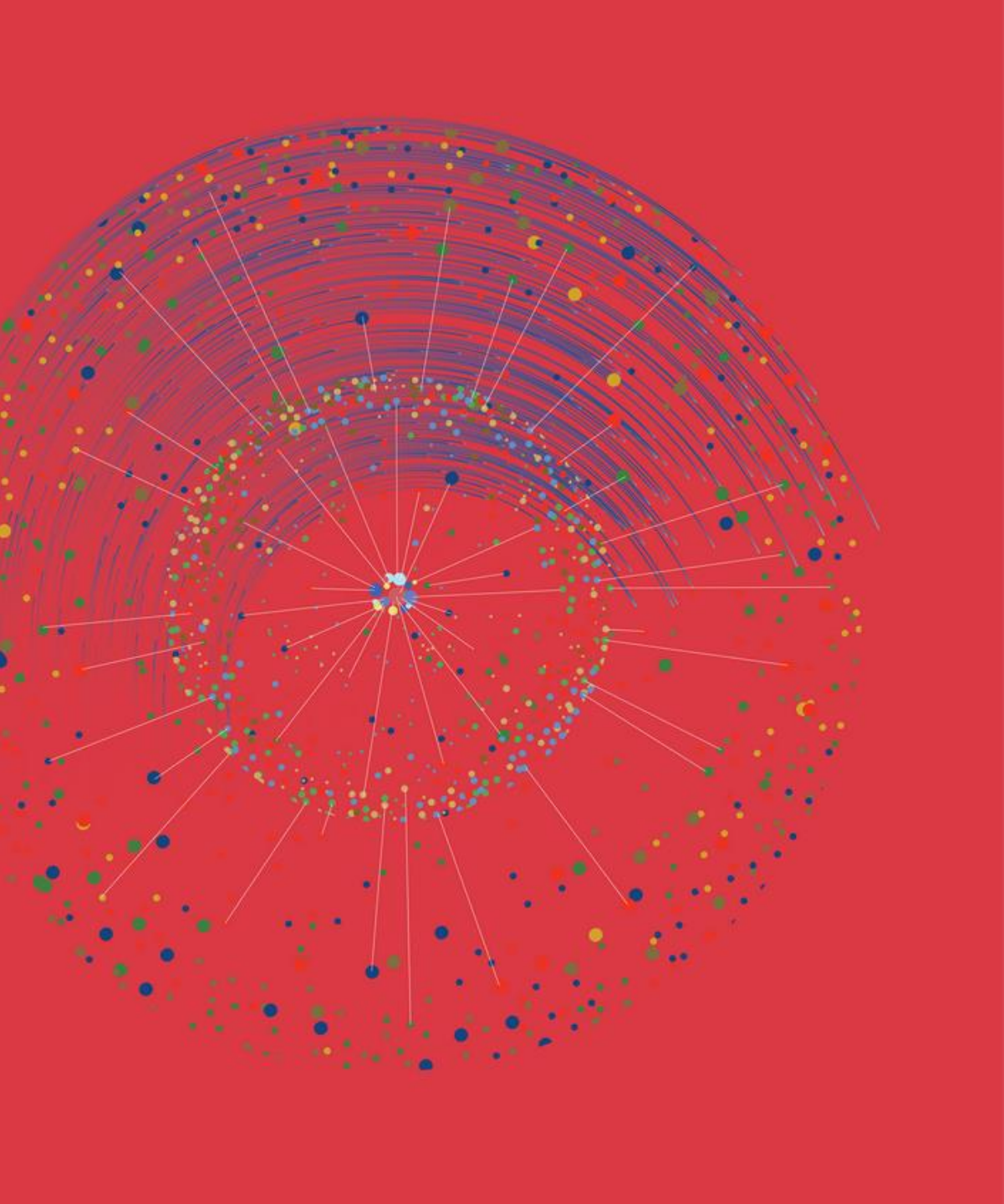

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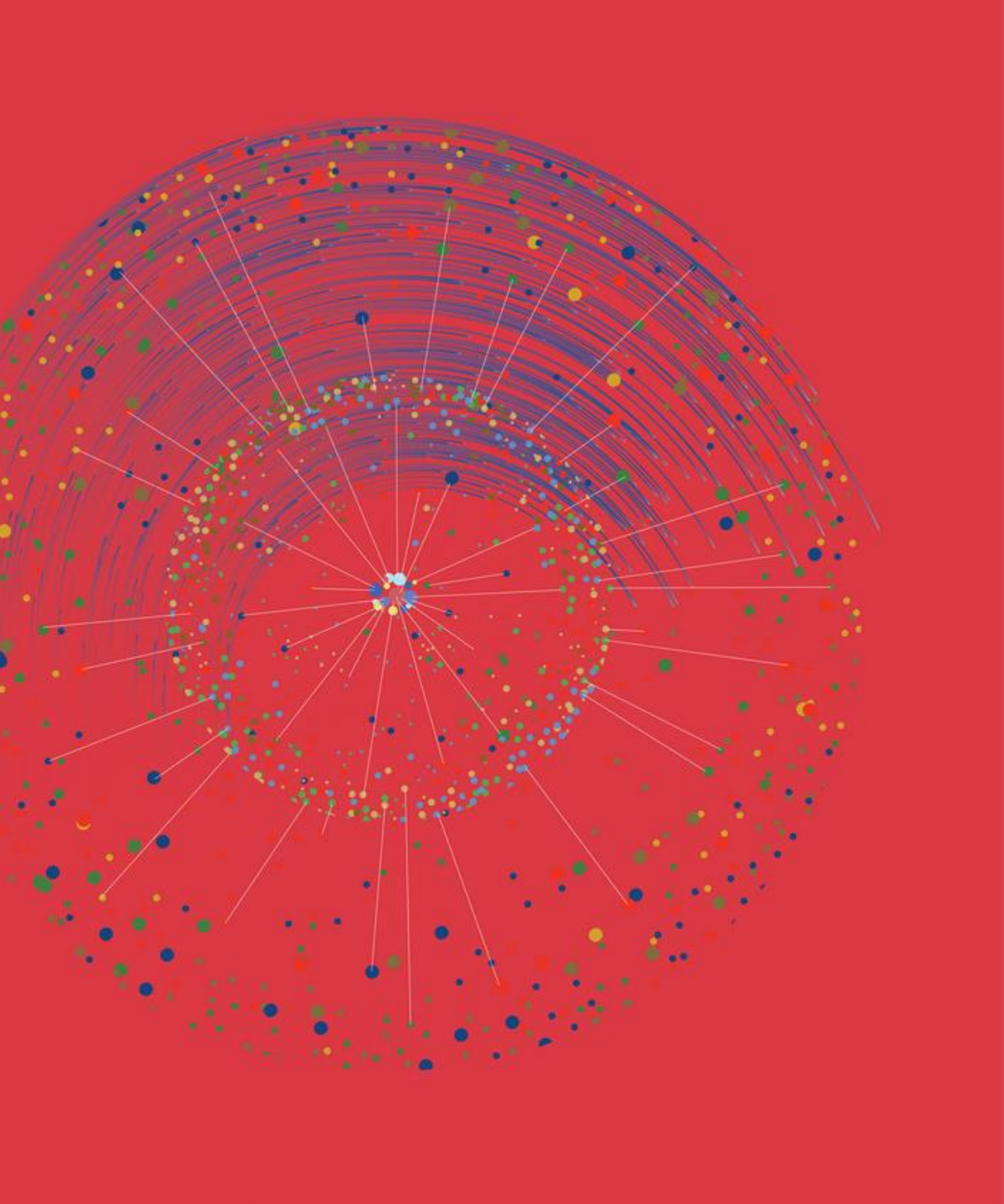
