

Japan's proposal for a draft CMA decision on the Glasgow–Sharm el-Sheikh work programme on the global goal on adaptation referred to in decision 7/CMA.3

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement,

Recalling Article 7, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement and decision 7/CMA.3,

- 1. Welcomes* work undertaken under the Glasgow Sharm el-Sheikh work programme on the global goal on adaptation in 2022;
- 2. Resolves* to continue working on the eight objectives of the work programme, as contained in paragraph 7 of decision 7/CMA.3 with a focus on evaluating the progress of adaptation, sharing good practices of adaptation actions, and sharing support needs;
- 3. Recognizes* the importance of the private sector in strengthening adaptation actions at all levels and increased private sector involvement in adaptation to complement public sector adaptation actions.
- 4. Also recognizes* the difficulties relating to reviewing and evaluating overall progress in achieving the global goal on adaptation given the challenges deriving from each country's uniqueness and local characteristics;
- 5. Also recognizes* that there is no one uniform quantitative goal to reviewing overall progress toward achieving the global goal on adaptation;
- 6. Endorses* the use of approaches to assessing progress along the adaptation policy cycle, which is comprised of risk and vulnerability assessments, planning, implementation, and monitoring and evaluation, and learning;
- 7. Recalls* paragraph 12 of decision 7/CMA.3, in which it decided to conduct four workshops per year, namely two virtual intersessional workshops and two workshops in conjunction with the sessions of the subsidiary bodies, bearing in mind the opportunities of virtual meetings for being inclusive and efficient, taking due consideration for treating in-person and virtual participants equally. ;
- 8. Decides* to hold the first workshop in 2023 no later than in April and the fourth workshop in 2023 six weeks before the fifth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (November 2023);
- 9. Requests* the secretariat to publish the single annual report on the workshops referred to in paragraph 16 of decision 7/CMA.3 three weeks before the fifth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement;
- 10. Invites* Parties and observers to submit by the end of April 2023, via the submission portal, their contributions to the workshops, noting that submissions made after this deadline will not be considered as a basis for the workshops;
- 11. Requests* the Chairs of the subsidiary bodies, with the support of the secretariat, to prepare a concept note and guiding questions relating to the themes and areas of work no later than two weeks prior to each workshop, based on the submissions referred to in paragraph 10 above;

12. *Decides* that the topics for the four workshops in 2023 are:

- a. Enhancing action and support and assessing progress on adaptation at all levels, promoting private investments and businesses while leveraging the potential of non-Party stakeholders such as local communities and indigenous peoples;
- b. Cross-cutting topics such as the transboundary impacts of climate change and locally and indigenous-led adaptation action;
- c. Long-term goals in the Paris Agreement, in particular those included in Article 2, paragraph 1, including how they inform national adaptation goals and targets;
- d. What evaluation criteria should be used in M&E to compile country-specific information and manage progress globally, with a view to inform to the global stocktake;

13. *Requests* that the actions of the secretariat called for in this decision be undertaken subject to the availability of financial resources.
