He has been intensively involved in the design of China's domestic carbon market. He was a lead author of the IPCC's Fourth Climate Change Assessment Report. He has published articles on various journals such as *Science*, *Ecological Economics*, *Energy Economics*, *Energy Policy*, *Climate Policy*, *iScience* and *Applied Energy*.
