Simon Fellermeyer is a policy advisor at the climate division of the Federal Office for the Environment of Switzerland. Simon is the Swiss lead negotiator on Article 6 of the Paris Agreement as well as coordinator of the Environmental Integrity Group (EIG) for international carbon markets. He serves as the Swiss Designated National Authority (DNA) to the Clean Development Mechanism. As part of his portfolio, Simon is also engaged in the negotiation and implementation of Switzerland's bilateral agreements for cooperation in the context of Article 6.2 of the Paris Agreement and works on Swiss domestic legislative requirements for international carbon markets. Prior to joining the Federal Office for the Environment in 2018, Simon worked on carbon markets at the World Bank in Washington DC, the German Development Agency in Mexico and the UNFCCC Secretariat in Bonn.

Simon holds a Master of Science in International Political Economy from the London School of Economics and Political Science and a Master of Arts in International Economic Policy from Sciences Po Paris. He completed his undergraduate studies with a Bachelor of Science in International Business Administration at Erasmus University Rotterdam.
