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MESSAGE TO CONSTITUENCIES OF ADMITTED NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

Nomination for participants to mandated events and information on other events

Climate Week - 3 Yeosu, Republic of Korea, 21 - 25 April 2026

The secretariat refers to the [Message to Parties and observers](#) dated 29 January 2026 regarding the Climate Week-3,¹ which will be held from 21 to 25 April 2026 in Yeosu, Republic of Korea.

This message to constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) includes information on mandated events taking place at the Climate Week-3 that are open for nomination of NGO representatives, as well as the corresponding participation modalities. All mandated events will be organized in accordance with their respective mandates under the respective governing and subsidiary bodies.

The Climate Week-3 will also host the Implementation Forum, with the overall objective to focus on actionable solutions, bringing together implementers and policymakers to accelerate climate action. More information on the Forum can be found in section III.

Participation in mandated events is facilitated through the [NGO constituencies](#), so as to aim for a balanced representation of the admitted non-governmental organizations. Please note that nomination of representatives will be at the discretion of the respective NGO constituencies. In this context, constituency focal points are invited to carefully review the information contained in sections I - IV of this communication.

I. Nomination and registration for mandated events

CFPs are invited to nominate participants for in-person attendance and virtual participation, where applicable, for the mandated events listed below.

Nomination lists of representatives to mandated events should be communicated to the secretariat by the CFPs via cool@unfccc.int by **27 March 2026, CEST 23:59** at the latest. CFPs are further encouraged to nominate individuals with expertise and experience relevant to the event for which they are nominated.

Admitted NGOs are advised that nomination through the CFPs is the only official channel for nominating participants for the events during the Climate Week-3. The secretariat is not in a position to process nominations submitted by any other method. Please note that it is imperative that a correct and unique email address be provided for each nominated participant for swift processing of nominations and initiating registration. Once a participant has been nominated for an event, they will receive an email with registration details via **Indico UN** registration platform. The nominated in-person participants will be self-funded and responsible for covering all expenses related to their travel arrangements, unless otherwise communicated.

In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the Climate Week-3 events as early as possible, the secretariat will not be in a position to process late nominations.

III. Implementation Forum

The **Implementation Forum** will take place on 23 and 24 April 2026 and will feature a series of events, including Implementation labs, Impact dialogues and COP presidency events, focused on actionable solutions, bringing together implementers and policymakers to accelerate climate action. The thematic focus of the events will be based on the six axes of the global climate action agenda¹⁰ ensuring alignment to the first GST outcomes. The implementation forum is a key pillar of the Climate Weeks, under which Parties and non-Party stakeholders can exchange on practical implementation solutions. Convening these discussions at the Climate weeks, it localizes the Action Agenda, highlighting region-specific initiatives while drawing on global expertise.
