# Carbon Removals: "Reimagining Carbon Removals

Vision Statement	What are the visions for the future you want to explore? In this session we envision a future where, in parallel with rapid reductions, we are taking CO <sub>2</sub> out of the air at the scale needed to achieve net zero in an effective, affordable and equitable way and start reversing climate change. We then work back from the future to identify the grand challenges we must tackle now to get there.
Challenges	<ul> <li>What challenges are you experimenting with to get there?</li> <li>In building a common view of a future with removals, we will look behind three of the fault-lines that currently hamper the effective use and growth of carbon removals: <ul> <li>Global South v. Global North: How can the developing world benefit socially and economically from both nature-based and engineered carbon removals - and what is the responsibility of developed nations?</li> <li>Nature v. Tech: What will it take to get support for a holistic and systemic approach to removals that ensures a portfolio of solutions, addresses durability and gets away from "green vs chrome"?</li> <li>Reductions v. Removals: what needs to happen for carbon removals to be truly complementary and additional to reducing emissions - and not a distraction or excuse?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
