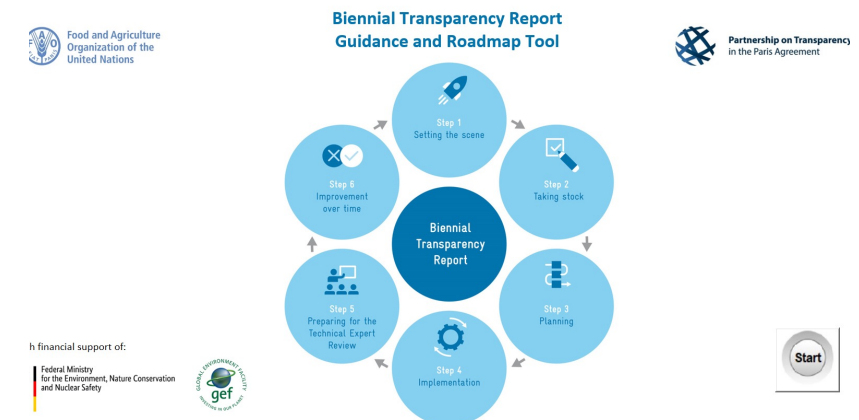
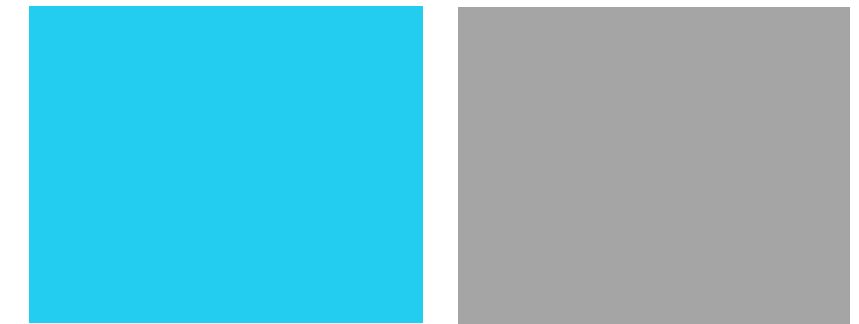

Cambodia: BTR Roadmap Tool

- Cambodia has begun initial discussions on the preparation of the BTR.
- Cambodia has already done some user testing of the BTR Roadmap tool.
- It is a very useful tool for identifying the key aspects where there are gaps which need to be addressed.
- It will be useful for developing BTR plan between now and 2024 for possibility submission of the first BTR.





Cambodia: Current practices and key lesson learnt

Based on the previous experience on the formulation of the Biennial Update Report:

- ☐ Setting up the Institutional Arrangement
- ☐ Development of methodology to collect Activity Data but remained challenge aspects
- ☐ Identification and involving all relevant line ministries to ensure full coordination and engagement within the country.
- ☐ A BUR coordination team needs to be put in place to facilitate the process.
- ☐ An ad hoc Greenhouse Gas Inventory (GHGI) had been established and a team of international experts had been recruited to help the BUR compilation
- ☐ The BUR development provided valuable lessons learned received from implementation and roster expert BUR technical review after submission to UNFCCC to guide the development of BTR as the BTR tool could provide useful guidance and roadmap to complete the BTR in the limited timeframe.
- ☐ Good progress had been made in the MRV of REDD+, technical capacity had been improved. The technical annex for REDD+ result-based payment also developed and submitted along with the BUR. For the future Cambodia might also continue to submit the technical annex as Cambodia had an existing MRV team; as it can provide support the REDD+ process in the country.
- ☐ BUR roster expert joins technical review with the Ministry of Environment to identify gaps, capacity needs and consistency in the report.

Pathway to BTR preparation

- ❑ In Cambodia the preparation of the BTR still requires a lot of effort and commitment.
- ❑ There are needed to improve technical capacity for enhancing of activity data within a common data template where it can be adopted from all relevant sectors.
- ❑ The Reform of GHGI taskforce needs to be ready for all sectors.
