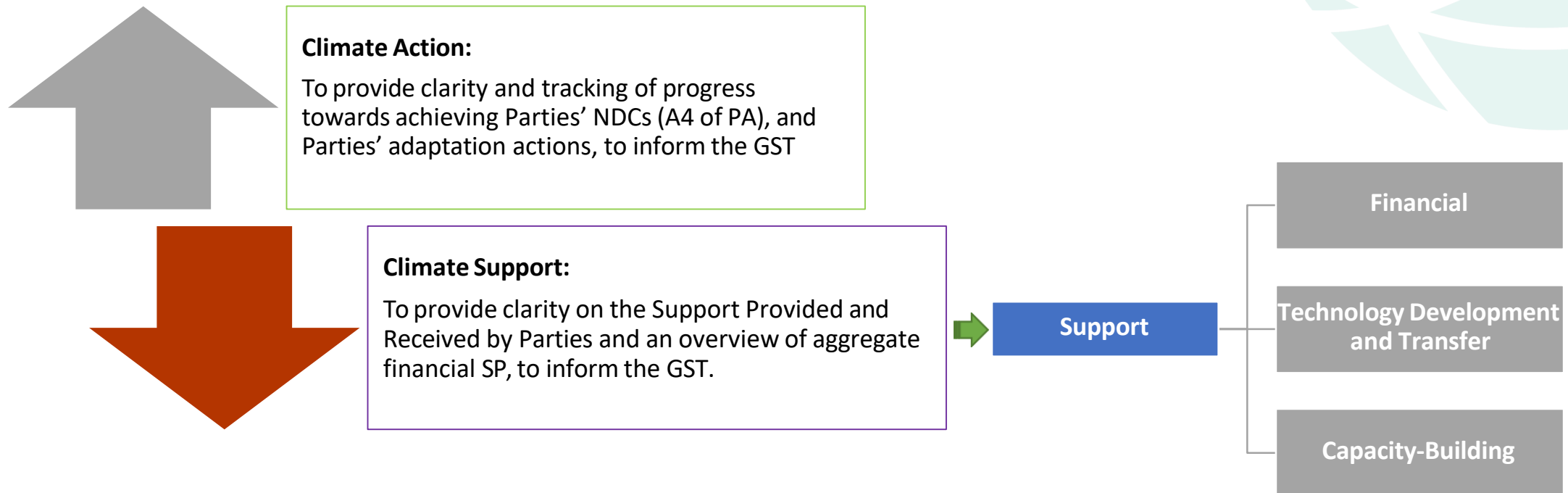

Transparency in the context of the MPGs

Article 13 decision 18/CMA.1, Paris Agreement adopts the enhanced transparency framework (ETF) for action and support

The ETF is a common framework applicable to all Parties, with specific flexibility provisions provided to developing country Parties that need it in the light of their capacities in its implementation.

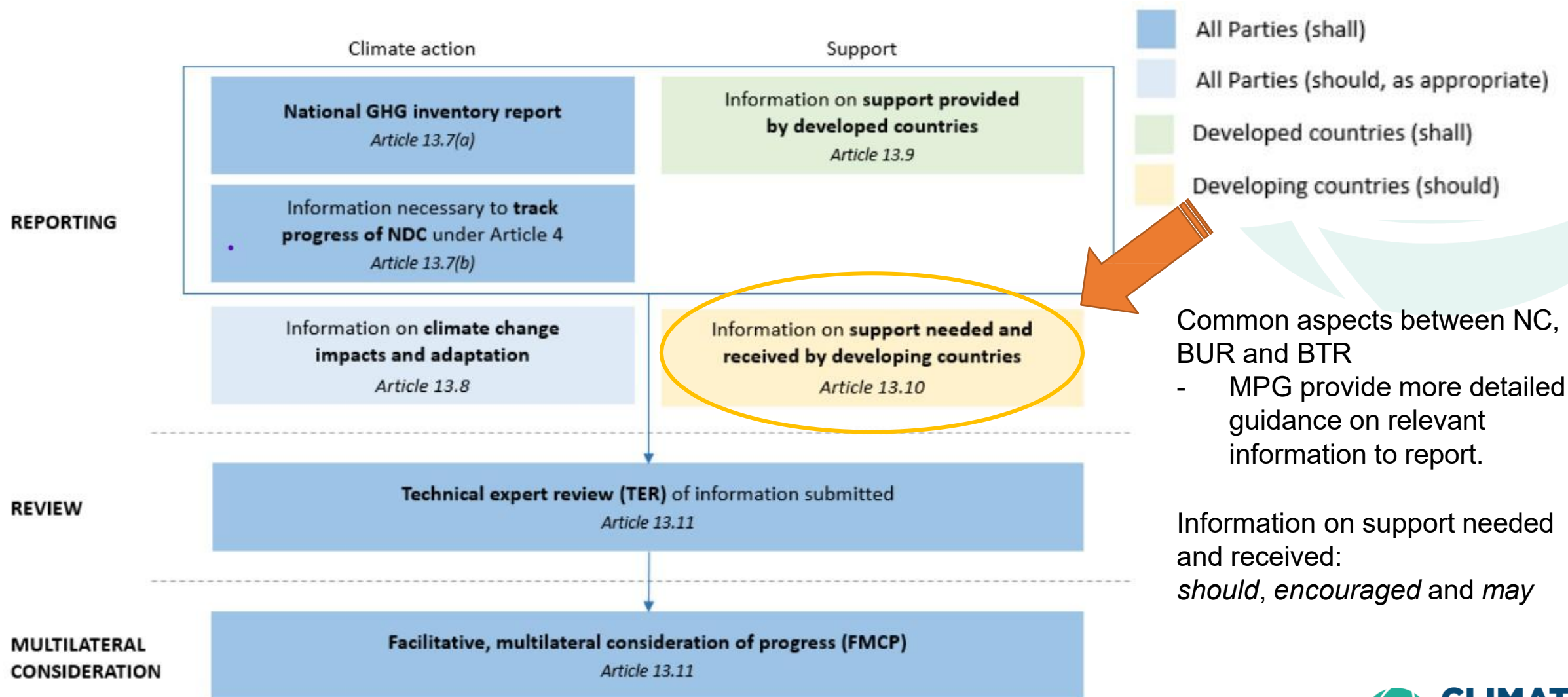

“Developing country Parties should provide information on FTC support needed and received, **to the extent possible, and as available and as applicable.**”

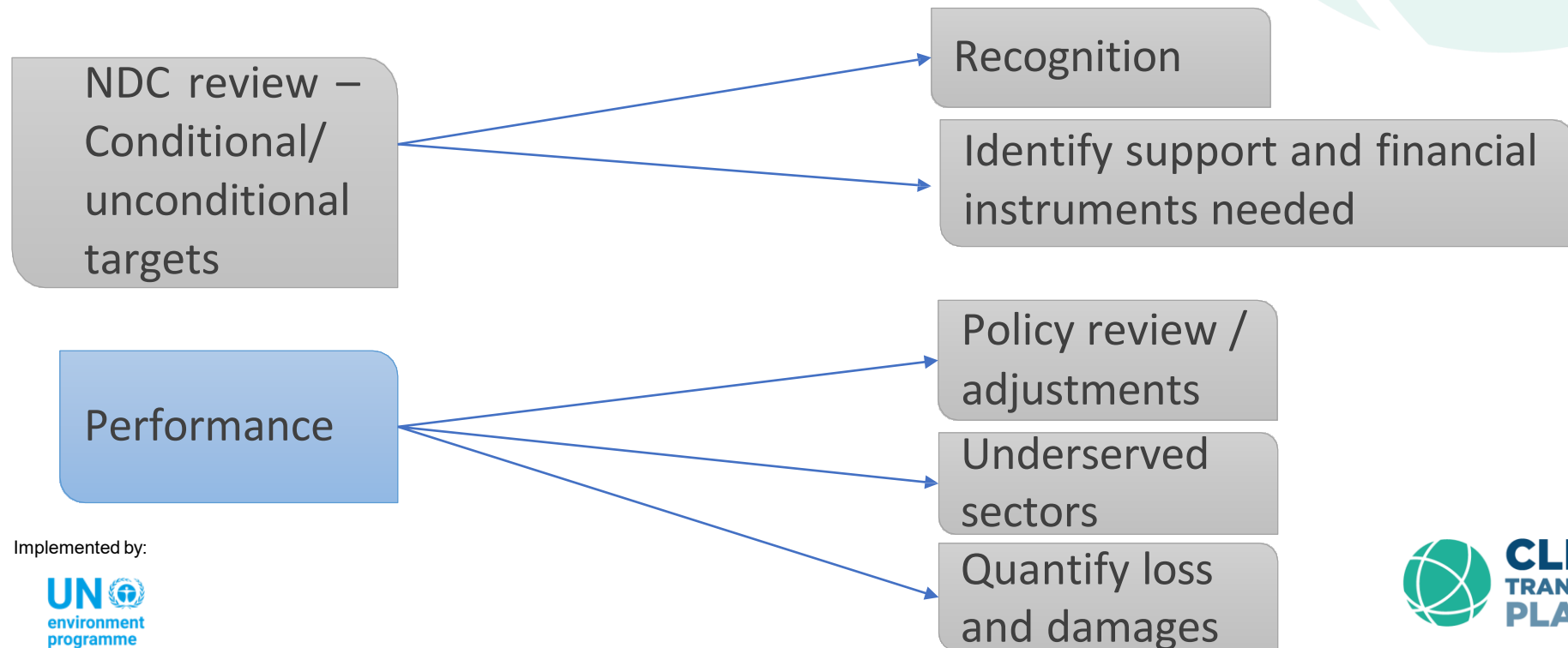

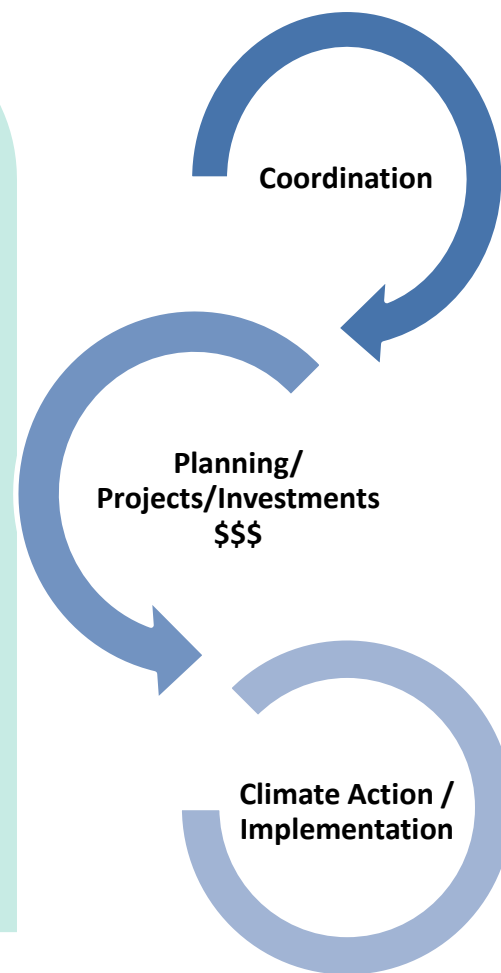

How Countries strengthen coordination? CFUs

- CFUs bridge finance and transparency in climate governance.
- They ensure countries can track, report, and mobilize resources effectively.
- Provide structured data for reporting under the Enhanced Transparency Framework.
- ***Key role: turning commitments into actionable, financed plans.***



- CFUs align financial flows with NDC targets.
- Facilitate budgeting, costing, and investment pipelines for mitigation/adaptation.
- Enable cross-ministry coordination (finance, environment, planning)
- Eg: integration of climate risks into national budgets.
