2nd Capacity-building Hub at COP25: Bringing together relevant stakeholders in the process to enable joint discussion and promote coherence and coordination of capacity-building activities

- Hosted by the Paris Committee on Capacity-building (PCCB), and with the support of the UN Climate Change Secretariat, the 2nd Capacity-building Hub took place over the course of seven thematic days, on December 4-11 at COP25, in Madrid.
- The thematic day of 'Means of Implementation' was particularly relevant under the theme of coherence and coordination as it brought together capacity-building actors to share best practices and practice peer-to-peer learning. The PCCB collaborated with constituted bodies such as the Adaptation Fund, Green Climate Fund and the TEC to organize this day.

Informal Coordination Mechanism (ICM)

- The PCCB has identified the need for an enhanced space for coordination and collaboration outside the annual meetings of the PCCB, and for defining common areas of interest which would help increase synergies and reduce duplication of efforts.
