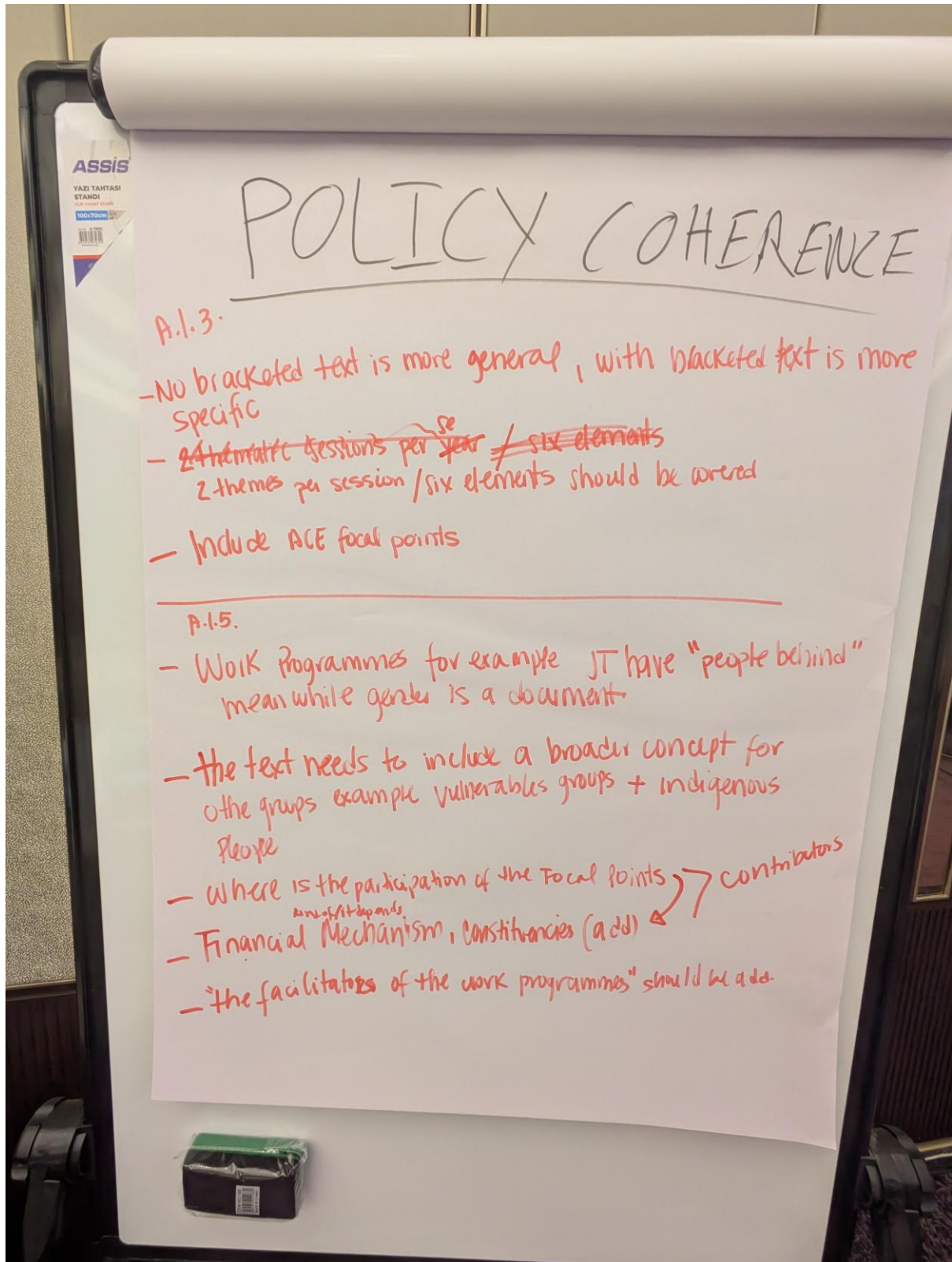

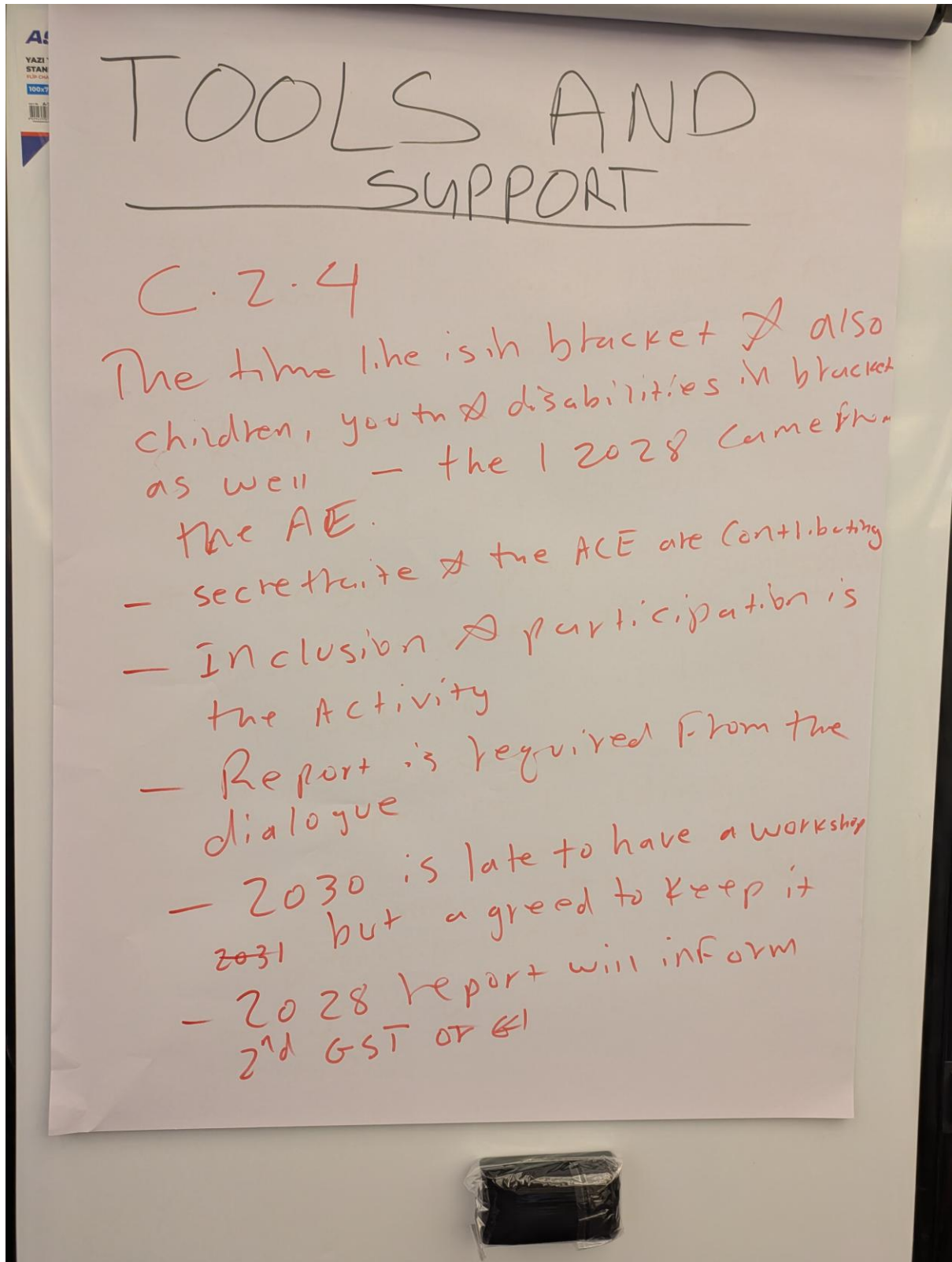
- Reach out to vulnerable groups

Tools and support



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- Internationally it is clear but clarity is needed at the national / regional level. (no specific target)
- Selecting one specific year (either 2028, or 2030)
- 2030 is proposed for the workshop in terms of feasibility (to inform Glasgow work plan) (2028, not optimal to do it)
- The E-courses are available for capacity building.
- Safe is linked to Safeguards requirement making children participation difficult.
- 2030 will inform NDC 3.0.

- The ACE & Aradancy is very specific should not be included in

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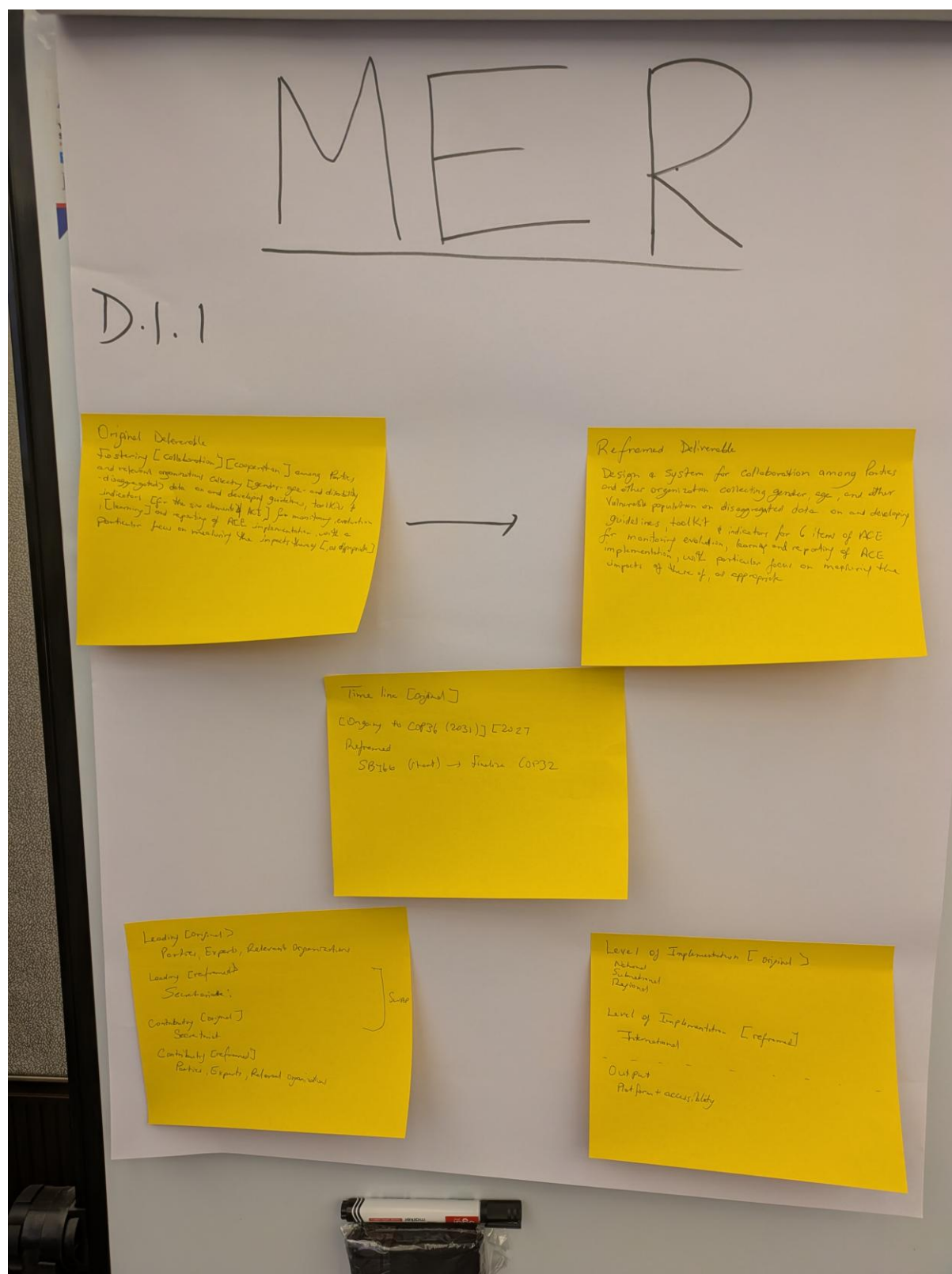
the deliverable.
