Webinar series on Article 6 of the Paris Agreement

Introduction

Article 6 of the Paris Agreement establishes three approaches for Parties to voluntarily cooperate in achieving their emission reduction targets and adaptation aims set out in their national climate action plans under the Paris Agreement (Nationally Determined Contributions, or NDCs). The advancement of Article 6 implementation will require a common and collective understanding of the rules adopted at COP26 in Glasgow and COP27 in Sharm El-Sheik, the conversations happened in SBSTA 58 in Bonn and the outcomes of the recent meetings of the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body.

To this end, the UN Climate Change through its Regional Collaboration Centers (RCCs) are organizing webinar series to provide Parties with an opportunity to discuss and share views on the various elements of Article 6. The webinars are propaedeutic to the Article 6 in-person trainings that UN Climate Change will organize at the margin of the Regional Climate Weeks 2023.

Objectives

The objective of the webinars is to increase key stakeholders' understanding and readiness for participation in Article 6. The webinars will focus on participation requirements for Articles 6.2 cooperative approaches and Article 6.4 mechanism.

The specific objectives of the of webinars are to:

- Enhance overall understanding of the provisions of Article 6 of the Paris Agreement, including participation requirements.
- Provide an overview of the different ways in which countries can cooperate under Article 6.2 to achieve their NDC;

- Share information on existing Article 6 programs and initiatives;
- Provide participants with a platform to share their experiences and lessons learned.
