IN BONN 04 - 07 October 2022

I. Mandate

The conclusions of the 56th meeting of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) specify the following mandates:

a. Article 6.2 (para 8): The SBSTA requested the secretariat to organize a series of virtual technical workshops followed by an in-person technical workshop with possibility of virtual participation, to be held before SBSTA 57 (November 2022), to consider the elements referred to in paragraph 6, taking into account the submissions referred to in paragraph 5 and the technical paper referred to in paragraph 6, ensuring broad participation of Parties.

b. Article 6.4 (para 5): The SBSTA requested the secretariat, before SBSTA 57 (November 2022), to organize a series of virtual technical workshops followed by an in-person technical workshop with possibility of virtual participation, to consider the elements referred to in paragraph 4, taking into account the submissions referred to in paragraph 3 and the technical papers referred to in paragraph 4, ensuring broad participation of Parties.

c. The secretariat is mandated by parties to deliver capacity building through the regional collaboration centers in consultation with the parties and supervisory body (for Article 6.4) on specific areas as included in paragraph 12 of decision 2/CMA.3 and paragraph 14 of decision 3/CMA.3. In relation to that the SBSTA at its 56th session requested the secretariat to update regularly the status of the work on the capacity-building programme including presenting the implementation plan at the in-person technical workshop for feedback from Parties.

II. Objective and scope of the technical workshop

- 2. The **objective** of the technical workshop is to bring together experts from Parties to exchange on technical issues and develop options to assist the SBSTA chair in the preparation of the informal document including textual proposals on various topics indicated in section V below.
- 3. The **discussions and output** of the workshop will assist the SBSTA chair to prepare the informal document, including textual proposals, for consideration by the SBSTA in recommending a draft decision on the two items of Article 6.
- 4. The secretariat would update the current status of its work on the capacity-building and seek feedback from parties.

III. Participation

5. Parties are invited to register up to two participants with the relevant technical background. Broadcast links will be available for observers to follow the workshop.

IV. Facilitation

6. The technical workshop will be led by facilitators, invited by the SBSTA Chair.

V. Format and timing

- 7. The technical workshop will be run as a **hybrid event**, as agreed in SBSTA 56.
- 8. Each session will commence with a presentation by the secretariat on the technical paper, followed by presentations by Parties identified including based on requests and submissions made. The presentations will be followed by discussions among Parties using guiding questions to support focused interventions on the following topics:
