

The Global Mutirão: Planetary Transformation from the Ground Up

SB62 (Bonn, June 2025)

Overview

The Brazilian culture inherited from its native Indigenous peoples the concept of *mutirão*. It refers to a community coming together to work on a shared task, whether harvesting, building, or supporting one another. Drawing on this invaluable ancestral wisdom and social technology, the Incoming COP30 Presidency shared the vision of a Global *Mutirão* – a global mobilization against climate change.

In its second letter, the COP30 President-Designate invited stakeholders to co-create a framework for the Global *Mutirão*, which will integrate decentralized, bottom-up, and self-organized initiatives into an aligned global mobilization, rooted in solidarity, cooperation, and shared purpose. This collective co-creation work started at Panama Climate Week, where stakeholders shared potential modalities for individuals, communities, and organizations to present self-determined contributions to the Global *Mutirão*, while building networks of cooperation and sharing experiences that can inspire new initiatives to further accelerate solution-oriented climate action.

At the Bonn Climate Change Conference, the Global *Mutirão* will bring to life a constellation of platforms and activities designed to connect and integrate aligned local actions into the Global *Mutirão* framework. SB62 will mark the launch of the first prototypes to form the constellation of integrators within the *Mutirão* framework. These will include digital platforms developed by Visão Coop, the Iswe Foundation, and the Institute for Technology and Society (ITS). Bonn will also be an opportunity for participants to share their own perspectives and experiences on local and integrating initiatives, while providing assembly space for discussions on what the Global *Mutirão* could become, helping co-create a truly inclusive world movement on climate.

Objectives

- Showcase the Incoming COP30 Presidency's vision for a Global *Mutirão*.
- Introduce the collaboration with Visão Coop, the Iswe Foundation and ITS.
- Launch prototypes of integrators to gather and mobilize self-determined contributions.
- Invite participants to share ideas and actions that will strengthen this emerging framework.
