Cooperation with other international organizations

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) welcomed the summary of the secretariat's cooperative activities with United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations for May 2020 to May 2021,¹ as well as the previous summary for June 2019 to May 2020, prepared in 2020.²
- 2. The SBSTA also welcomed the information event, held during its May–June 2021 session, on the secretariat's cooperation with United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations.
- 3. The SBSTA noted the importance of the secretariat's cooperation, within the scope of existing mandates provided by the governing bodies, with relevant United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations in relation to supporting Parties' efforts to enhance the ambition of their climate action, including with regard to mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation, and contributing to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- 4. The SBSTA encouraged its Chair to continue to provide opportunities for Parties and stakeholders to exchange views on progress of the secretariat's cooperative activities referred to in paragraph 1 above and to provide guidance to the secretariat on this matter at future sessions.
