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NDCs at COP31

- Submission of remaining NDCs, NAPs, and BTRs is an opportunity to celebrate collective commitment to the Paris Agreement
- According to the **2025 NDC Synthesis Report**, 88% of Parties indicated that the preparation of their NDCs was informed by the outcomes of the first GST – demonstrating the strength of our Paris process
- Want to work together to encourage follow through on key Paris Agreement fundamentals

Australia is co-chair of the NDC Partnership with Brazil, a global coalition of more than 260 countries and institutions working together to accelerate ambitious climate action.

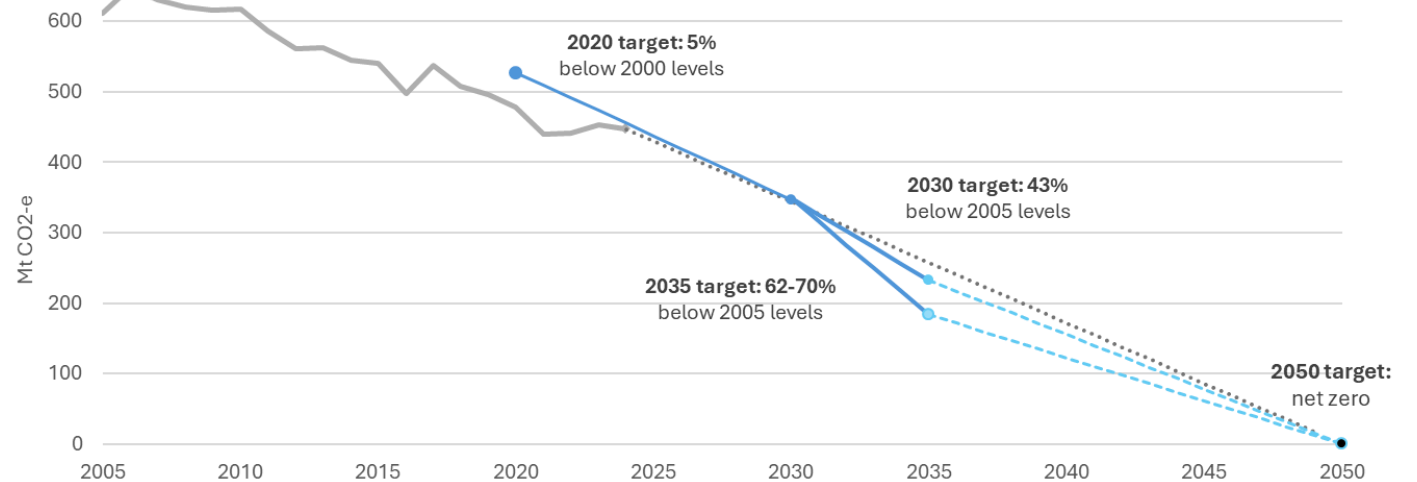
Australia's priorities as co-chair include:

Australia's 2035 Nationally Determined Contribution

Australia's 2035 target is a 62-70% reduction in national emissions below 2005 levels, covering all sectors of the economy and all greenhouse gases.

- Ambitious and achievable
- A target aligned with the science
- Accelerating Australia's energy transition
- Built on strong policy foundations
- Underpinned by comprehensive plans



Strong policy foundations - Climate Change Act 2022

Legislative framework providing the robust setting needed to consider GST outcomes in our NDC

Ambition and targets

- Legislates 2030 target & net zero by 2050 target
- Targets must align with the Paris Agreement
- Government cannot set new targets without considering independent advice of the Climate Change Authority (CCA)

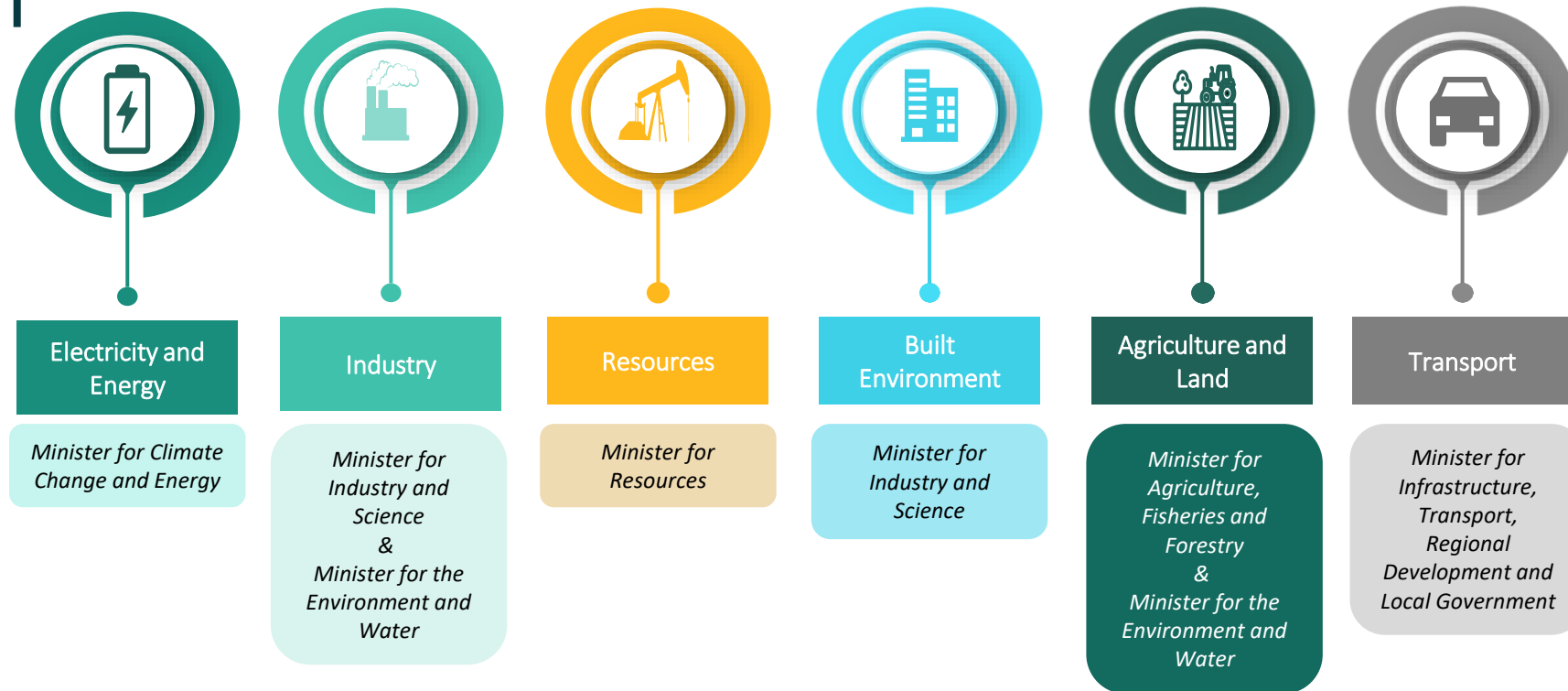
Transparency & Accountability

- The government must publicly report progress each year in an Annual Climate Change Statement to Parliament
- The CCA also reports and advises on progress & makes recommendations to government each year.
