Official opening ceremony of the conference and the high-level segment for Heads of State and Government

The official opening ceremony of the conference and high-level segment of COP 24/CMP 14/ CMA 1.3 to be attended by Heads of State and Government, will take place in Plenary Mazowsze today at 10.00 hrs. The opening will be presided over by Mr. Michał Kurtyka, President of COP 24/CMP 14/CMA 1.3, and will be attended by His Excellency Mr. Andrzej Duda, President of the Republic of Poland, Mr. António Guterres, Secretary-General of the United Nations, Her Excellency, Ms. María Fernanda Espinosa Garcés, President of the United Nations General Assembly and Ms. Patricia Espinosa Cantellano, UNFCCC Executive Secretary.

Heads of State and Government are expected to arrive by 09.30 hrs. Participants are asked to take their seats in Plenary Mazowsze by 09.45 hrs. to ensure that the opening can begin promptly.

The conference will hear national statements from Heads of State and Government and the delivery of national statements is expected to finish at approximately 18.00 hrs.

The [list of speakers](#) has been established in accordance with the time of inscription and reflecting protocol order in accordance with United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, with Heads of State speaking before Heads of Government.

Special tickets are needed to access Plenary Mazowsze for the opening of the conference and the high-level segment. They are distributed at the Information Desk of the conference venue **on Monday, 3 December**. Delegations are requested to pick up these tickets and will be required to confirm receipt.

Parties are guaranteed four seats per delegation. UN organizations and IGOs are guaranteed two seats per delegation. For NGOs, a limited number of tickets are distributed through the [Constituencies](#). Please contact your Constituency Focal Points for information.

Please be advised that security and fire regulations do not permit participants to stand and security will enforce this requirement.

The proceedings can be followed on [webcast](#) and on the TV screens throughout the Conference Centre as well as viewing the proceedings in Plenary Śląsk without restriction.

Following the closure of the high-level segment, Heads of State and Government, Heads of delegations and other guests are invited to the Concert of the Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra to be held at the NOSPR Concert Hall at 18.30 hrs. Following the concert, invited guests will be transported to the official dinner for Heads of State and Government hosted by the President of the Republic of Poland at the Muzeum Śląskie.

The IPCC, in response to the invitation by COP 21, has made available a special report entitled: “Global Warming of 1.5°C, an IPCC special report on the impacts of global warming of 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels and related global greenhouse gas emission pathways, in the context of strengthening the global response to the threat of climate change, sustainable development, and efforts to eradicate poverty.” It was adopted at IPCC 48 (Incheon, 1-5 October 2018).

The event will introduce to Parties the new scientific concepts and definitions used in the report. It will focus on the key findings of the report, including on the impacts of 1.5°C, structured in line with the Summary for Policy Makers (SPM).
