Duly signed original credentials, should be submitted in one of the six official languages of the United Nations to the Distribution Desk Counter in Service Hub South at the Conference venue. To ensure proper handling and delivery to the repository, no other office or authority of the secretariat or the host country has been designated to receive credentials.
