### Resumed High-Level Segment of COP 28/CMP 18/CMA 5

The resumed High-Level Segment of COP 28/CMP 18/CMA 5 will be held on Saturday, 9 December 2023 in Plenary Al Hairat and will begin at 10.00 hrs. The resumed High-Level Segment will hear national statements from those Parties whose Head of State or Government did not deliver a national statement on 1 or 2 December during the first part of the High-Level Segment for Heads of State and Government held during the World Climate Action Summit, and representatives of groups who have registered and confirmed their wish to deliver a national or group statement.

Upon conclusion of national statements, the resumed High-Level Segment will hear statements from Intergovernmental organizations and groups of non-Governmental organizations admitted by the Conference of the Parties.

For the opening of the resumed High-Level Segment and delivery of national statements, access is open to all Parties including overflow and United Nations organizations.
