### Opening ceremony of the Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Implementation Summit

The opening ceremony of the [Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Implementation Summit](#) will take place in Plenary Nefertiti today at 12.15 hrs. The Summit will be attended by His Excellency Mr. Abdel Fattah El-Sisi, President of the Arab Republic of Egypt, Mr. António Guterres, Secretary-General of the United Nations, Heads of State and Government, Mr. Simon Stiell, UNFCCC Executive Secretary and other specially invited guests.

Arrival of Heads of State and Government attending the Summit is expected until 11.45 hrs. Participants are asked to take their seats in Plenary Nefertiti by 12.00 hrs. to ensure that the opening can begin promptly.

Special tickets are needed to access Plenary Nefertiti for the opening of the Summit. Four seats per Party delegation, including the seat of the Head of State or Government, will be made available behind the nameplate of each Party for the opening ceremony. Access to Plenary Nefertiti for the opening ceremony of the Summit will require a lapel pin for the Head of State or Government. For the delegates accompanying the Head of State or Government, a regular conference badge as well as a ticket for the opening of the Summit will be required. Tickets are distributed either through the liaison officer or at the Information Desk for those Parties whose Head of State or Government is not attending the Summit.

United Nations organizations, intergovernmental organizations, and constituencies of non-governmental organizations will be able to attend the opening of the Summit.

Tickets for focal points of non-governmental organizations constituencies are provided by the secretariat's observer relations teams.

Overflow rooms will also be available in Plenary Ramses for those persons who will not have a seat in the main plenary.

During the Summit, the first part of the high-level segment of COP 27/CMP 17/CMA 4 for Heads of State and Government will take place. The high-level segment will be opened at 14.30 hrs. by His Excellency Mr. Sameh Shoukry, President of COP 27/CMP 17/CMA 4. The conference will hear national statements from Heads of State and Government in Plenary Nefertiti as of 14.45 hrs. The delivery of national statements is expected to finish at approximately 18.30 hrs.

### **Egypt's message to NGOs on the Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Implementation Summit**

Below is a message from the COP 27 Presidency to the representatives of non-governmental organizations regarding the Opening Ceremony of the Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Implementation Summit on Monday, 7 November 2022. Please refer to the schedule for further details and timings. Please note that the Blue Zone itself will remain open to NGO badge holders. It is only the Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Implementation Summit and Roundtable rooms that are not accessible without specific invitations.

*“COP 27 has the highest number of registrations of any UNFCCC conference. This includes nearly 10,000 NGO participants. As you are possibly aware, room capacity is a constant constraint. For this reason, in-person participation of all representatives of non-governmental organizations observers will not be possible during the Sharm el-Sheikh Climate Implementation Summit on 7 and 8 November 2022. Therefore, we kindly invite you to follow this event online via the COP 27 virtual platform.*

*However, there will be 30 seats allocated to NGOs for access to the Opening Ceremony on Monday, 7 November 2022, in order to ensure NGO representation therein.*

*Given that there are only 30 seats for nearly 10,000 registered NGO participants and in consultation with the UNFCCC secretariat, these will be given to the Focal Points of NGO Constituencies and informal groups as personal invitations in recognition of their tireless efforts for coordinating hundreds of NGOs in the UNFCCC process throughout the year and also recognizing that they are well positioned to represent the NGO community with their deep understanding of the process and of the diverse voices of their respective NGO constituencies.”*
