Special Address by the President of the United States Joseph R. Biden Jr.

His Excellency Joseph R. Biden Jr., President of the United States of America will deliver remarks at the 27th session of the Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP 27). He will discuss efforts to build on the unprecedented work by the United States to reduce emissions, advance the global climate fight and help the most vulnerable build resilience to climate impacts.

A special session will take place on Friday, 11 November 2022 in Plenary Nefertiti at 16.45 hrs.

Taking into consideration the capacity of the room, and the safety and security of all participants, the event will be ticketed. Parties, United Nations secretariat units and bodies, Specialized agencies and related organizations and Intergovernmental organizations can collect up their tickets from the Information Desk, located in Area B of the conference venue. **Tickets can be collected on Thursday, 10 November from 10.00 – 17.00 hrs. and on Friday, 11 November from 10.00 – 13.00 hrs.**

Joint UNFCCC and UNEP special event on the Emissions Gap Report 2022
