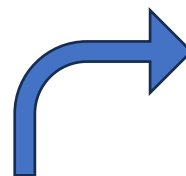

The Belém GAP: a new chapter for gender and climate change

- Adopted at COP 30 ([Belém gender action plan](#))
- **Operationalizes the enhanced Lima work programme on gender**
- **2026-2034, mid-term review in 2029**
- Similar structure previous GAP with **5 priority areas**
- **27 activities and 98 deliverables**
- **Implementation:**
 - **By all stakeholders:** governments, civil society, UN entities, relevant organizations
 - **At all levels,** from local to international



A: Capacity-building, knowledge management and communication
B: Gender balance, participation and women's leadership
C: Coherence
D: Gender-responsive implementation and means of implementation
E: Monitoring and reporting



A plan built for impact

- Strengthened focus on:
 - **Implementation** and **means of implementation**
 - **More structured deliverables** and **stage approach**
 - **Improved evidence base, data, reporting** (e.g. voluntary Party reporting) and **accountability**
- **Better systems** and **improved mainstreaming** across and beyond the convention
 - Constituted bodies and work programmes, JTWP, GST
 - IPCC
 - Rio Conventions

- A.3 Strengthen the evidence base for and understanding of the **differentiated impacts and opportunities of climate change and climate action**, and the **role of women, men and boys as agents of change**
 - A.3.1: **Capacity-building programmes and national dialogues** (*ongoing; national level*) **L C**
 - A.3.2 Education, training and awareness-raising campaigns (*ongoing; regional and national level*) **L C C**
 - A.3.3 Virtual or hybrid workshops on gender- and climate-related matters (*in conjunction with relevant regional events; regional and international level*) **L C**
- A.4 Enhance **capacity-building for governments and other relevant stakeholders in collecting, analysing and applying gender- and age disaggregated data** and conducting **gender analysis**
 - A.4.1 Building, strengthening and maintenance of the evidence base on gender and climate change matters (*ongoing; at all levels*) **L L C C C**

Strengthening collection and use of gender and climate change data

- A.3 Strengthen the **evidence base** for and **understanding of the differentiated impacts and opportunities of climate change and climate action**, and agents of change role, of women, men and boys
 - A.3.5 Submissions on the evidence base on gender and climate and of gender-responsive climate action, including multidimensional factors, and examples of engaging men and boys and of gender-responsive climate action (*by June 2027; all levels*) **L L L C C**
 - A.3.6 Synthesis report on the submissions referred to in A.3.5 above (*COP 32; international level*) **L**
 - A.3.9 Submissions on the findings of national assessments of relevant issues, such as health, violence against women and girls, and care work in the context of gender and climate change (*by March 2027; international level*) **L L**
 - A.3.10 Dialogue on the findings reported in the submissions referred to in A.3.9 above (*COP 32; international level*) **L C C C**
 - A.3.11 Workshops on the findings of national assessments of relevant issues in the context of gender and climate change (*Ongoing; international, regional*) **L L**

Strengthening collection and use of gender and climate change data

- D.5 Support the **collection and consolidation of information on gender and climate change** in sectors and thematic areas as well as **identify experts** on gender and climate change and **enhance knowledge platforms** on gender and climate change
 - D.5.1 Report on commonalities between existing knowledge platforms and expert platforms, as well as potential gaps (*SB 66; international level*) **L**
 - D.5.2 Expert dialogue on relevant issues in gender and age-disaggregated data and gender analysis (*SB 64; international level*) **L C C C**
 - D.5.3 Strengthen existing knowledge and expertise platforms on gender and climate change matters and respond to identified gaps following the outcomes of the expert dialogue (*ongoing; national, regional and international level*) **L L L**
- D.7 **Enhance the collection, analysis, dissemination, management** and use of **gender- and age-disaggregated data** for gender analysis
 - D.7.2 Global dialogue on gender and environment data to exchange best practices (*COP 32 and COP 37; international level*) **L C C**

- A.3 Strengthen the **evidence base** for and **understanding of the differentiated impacts and opportunities of climate change and climate action**, and agents of change role, of women, men and boys
 - A.3.4 Inclusion of gender-responsive communication, public awareness-raising strategies and other relevant Action for Climate Empowerment elements in official climate planning and reporting processes (*ongoing; regional and national level*) **L L L**
- A.4 **Enhance the capacity of governments and other relevant stakeholders in collecting, analysing and applying gender- and age disaggregated data** and conducting **gender analysis**
 - A.4.2: Consideration of existing tools, guidelines, studies and trainings, identification of gaps, and development of new tools, guidelines, studies and trainings on the basis of the identified gaps (*ongoing; all levels*) **L**
 - A.4.3 Promotion of existing and new tools, guidelines, studies and trainings (*ongoing; regional, national and local level*) **L C C**

Monitoring and reporting

- E.1 Strengthen the **monitoring** of and **reporting on** the full, meaningful and equal **participation of women in leadership positions within the UNFCCC processes**
 - E.1.5 Voluntary reporting of gender composition of national delegations and technical teams supporting the COP Presidency and high-level champions, including on gender- and age disaggregated data (*annually; international and national level*) **L L**
 - E.1.6 Inclusion of additional data collection on multidimensional factors in registration processes for delegations and track progress over time (*ongoing, evaluation of progress in 2029; international and regional level*) **L C C**
- E.4 **Promote synergies** between the **enhanced LWPG** and its **GAP**, the work of the **IPCC** and work undertaken by Parties and relevant organizations in preparation for the GST regarding gender- and age-disaggregated data
 - E.4.1 Dialogue on synergies (*SB 68; international level*) **L C C C**
 - E.4.2 Dialogue report (*2028; international level*) **L**
