Item 4: Work of the expert groups of the Executive Committee

- 1. ExCom endorsed the Plans of Action (PoA) of the expert group on non-economic losses and slow onset events.
- ExCom noted the resignation of Jelena Milos from the technical expert group on comprehensive risk management (TEG-CRM) and elected Alfonso Pino Maeso as her successor.
- 3. ExCom elected Penehuro Lefale to serve in the expert group on slow onset events.
- 4. ExCom noted the representatives from the UN Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights and Internal Displacement Monitoring Center as ad hoc members of the task force on displacement (TFD).

Item 5: The role and contribution of the ExCom in the global stocktake as contained in decision 19/CMA.1

5. ExCom agreed to continue, intersessionally, its consideration of the table of contents of the synthesis report, based on the co-chairs' proposal contained in document "<u>Adopting the Table of Content for the Excom Synthesis Report for the Global Stocktake</u>".

6. ExCom agreed to continue, intersessionally, its consideration of potential priority themes to help increase the coherence and effectiveness of overall efforts under the WIM. The identification of the themes does not preclude the expert groups undertaking other work but is intended to enable the ExCom's work to be communicated in a focused way.
