NETWORK OF NATIONAL FOCAL POINTS TO THE UNITED NATIONS FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

Pursuant to decisions taken by the Subsidiary Body for Implementation, the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice and the Conference of the Parties (Documents FCCC/SBI/1996/9, para. 29, FCCC/SBSTA/1996/8, para. 74 and decision 14/CP.2), the Convention secretariat has developed a network of National Focal Points for activities pertaining to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

The large number of matters related to climate change and the increased number of national activities relevant to the Convention, call for a closer co-operation between the Convention secretariat and Parties and for improvement in their communications.

The main task to be carried out by the National Focal Point(s) were defined by the abovementioned subsidiary bodies. The National Focal Point(s) should be able to:

a) <u>Receive</u> copies of notification, documents, information regarding budgetary matters of the Convention secretariat and general data concerning the Convention, and <u>distribute</u> them to other concerned partners at the national level;

In addition, national focal point(s) could also perform the following functions:

- <u>Liaise</u> with the Convention secretariat on the preparation of national communication, in accordance with the pertinent provisions of the Convention and provide information regarding activities related to the Convention at the national level as well as the needs for financial and technical support to enable such activities;
- c) <u>Accept, approve or endorse</u> activities implemented jointly and report on them to the COP through the secretariat.

It would be appreciated if the Government, through its Ministry of Foreign Affairs, could identify the authority formally designated to act as the National Focal Point(s) for the functions as described in (a) above, indicating the name of the Ministry/institution, title, address, telephone, fax numbers and electronic address at the earliest opportunity. The Government could specify whether the focal point is also designated to perform the functions as described in (b) and (c) above.
