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### **Working paper by the Co-Facilitators**

*The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement,*

*Recalling* that climate change is a common concern of humankind, Parties should, when taking action to address climate change, respect, promote and consider their respective obligations on human rights, the right to health, the rights of indigenous peoples, local communities, migrants, children, persons with disabilities and people in vulnerable situations and the right to development, as well as gender equality, empowerment of women and intergenerational equity,

*Recalling* decisions 3/CMA.1,

1. *Welcomes* decision 1/CP.25;

### **{Completion of the Paris Agreement Work Programme}**

2. *Placeholder*

### **{Ambition: adaptation, mitigation and means of implementation}**

3. *Notes* with concern the state of the global climate system;
4. *Calls* to enhance ambition in line with the long-term goals as expressed in Article 2 of the Paris Agreement;
5. *Recognizes* that actions required to understand, and address climate change will be most effective if they are based on best available science and continually re-evaluated in the light of new findings;
6. *Emphasizes* the urgent need to achieve the global goal on adaptation referred to in Article 7, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement;
7. *Calls* on the Parties to accelerate their efforts towards achieving the global goal on adaptation to enhance adaptive capacity, strengthening resilience and reducing vulnerability to climate change, with a view to contributing to sustainable development and ensuring an adequate global adaptation response in the context of the temperature goal set out in Article 2 of the Paris Agreement;
8. *Also calls* on Parties to accelerate their efforts under Article 7, paragraph 9, of the Paris Agreement, including to formulate and implement national adaptation plans in accordance with the temperature goal referred to in Article 2 of the Paris Agreement;
9. *Urges* the Green Climate Fund to expedite support for the least developed countries and other developing countries for the formulation of national adaptation plans and for the subsequent implementation of policies, projects and programmes identified by them, pursuant to decision 1/CP.21, paragraph 46;
10. *Encourages* each Party to submit its first adaptation communication as soon as possible, so as to provide timely input to the first global stocktake;
11. *Recalls* its request for Parties to communicate new or updated nationally determined contributions, pursuant to decision 1/CP.21, paragraphs 23 and 24, that reflect their highest

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possible ambition, reflecting their common but differentiated responsibilities and respective capabilities, in the light of different national circumstances;

12. *Welcomes* the new and updated nationally determined contributions already been communicated by Parties;

13. *Reiterates* its strong encouragement to Parties to provide the information necessary for clarity, transparency and understanding contained in the annex of decision 4/CMA.1;

14. *Also reiterates* the invitation to Parties to communicate, by 2020, to the secretariat, mid-century long-term low greenhouse gas emission development strategies in accordance with Article 4, para. 19 of the Paris Agreement.
