Climate Finance Readiness Programme (2015-2018)

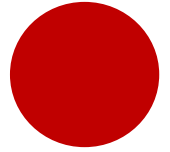
- Capacity building on various aspects of climate finance for different stakeholders e.g. government and private sector.
- Support to Uganda's NDA (MoFPED) to set up an institutional framework for GCF including the no objection process.
- Set up Uganda's Climate Finance Strategy
- Support to Uganda's MWE to gain accreditation to the GCF and AF

Green Economic Recovery in Uganda

- Resource mobilisation plan
- Development of new projects
- 6 priority areas for action identified

Support for the Energy and Banking Sectors

- Held climate finance trainings for Ugandan energy experts and representatives of the banking sector.
