COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS - CBIT PERÚ

Peru has been carrying out and implementing the Gender Action Plan, applying an intersectional perspective with an emphasis on intergenerational and intercultural characteristics.

COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS - CBIT ARGENTINA

Argentina has presented progress on the gender mainstreaming process under the framework of the National Climate Change Cabinet, emphasizing the adopted gender perspective. They have carried out trainings used to train technicians in the gender perspective and its mainstreaming

LTS - NDC ALIGNMENT

The EUROCLIMA+ project for long term strategies, comprised of five countries (Argentina, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Uruguay), has provided a tool for the construction of LTS. Throughout this project, the emphasis on how to build LTS that can fully incorporate gender goals has been at the forefront of the discussion through knowledge sharing spaces that discuss lesson-learned and paths to move forward.

MRV & M&E SYSTEMS

The team is in charge of conceptualising, designing and implementing the necessary instruments to build out the MRV systems of the mitigation actions and the M&E of the steps in adaptation with a gender-sensitive lens. The systems advance the effective management, reporting and communication of climate information.

Some of the projects that we managed, such as those of the Capacity Building Initiative for Transparency CBIT (Global Environment Facility), have successfully incorporated gender-sensitive MRV systems in the region by prioritising and recognising the need for sex-disaggregated data. Our CBIT projects are under implementation in Antigua & Barbuda, Argentina, Bahamas, Chile, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Honduras, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, República Dominicana, Trinidad & Tobago.

CLIMATE FINANCE

Through our CAEP projects (NDC Partnership) in Costa Rica, Panama & Honduras, we have helped orient the financing of climate action. We have enabled new sources of investment to face climate change with a gender lens. More recent projects are also looking at climate finance tracking to further transparency efforts in countries of the region. Our Climate Change Unit has also emphasised the importance of green recovery post-COVID-19 with a gender-sensitive approach for countries to consider in new recovery economic policies.

KNOWLEDGE PRODUCTION

The unit is developing a Transparency Report to gather information on the needs and gaps in the implementation of the national climate commitments of the region, including those on gender, just transition, participation and human rights. The report will shed light on what is still missing to fulfil international responsibilities.

We have also developed an introductory guide for gender mainstreaming that includes guidance on gender analysis and gender action plans.

CAPACITY BUILDING & PEER-TO-PEER EXCHANGES

We prioritise and facilitate bilateral and multilateral spaces for knowledge sharing and regional cooperation with other gender experts in the region. We have connected experiences in Argentina, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Peru, Uruguay on topics of gender.

WHAT WE ARE PROVIDING

Our team offers support in the development of public policy that aims to establish the guidelines and to strengthen the tools that will allow countries in the region to:

- Have reliable MRV & M&E systems that track the progress and compliance of, amongst others, the gender commitments set out in their Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and Long Term Strategies (LTS).
- Strengthen long-term planning exercises and link 2030 efforts with the 2050 vision in a coordinated attempt to implement the Paris Agreement, the Sustainable Development Goals and domestic policy in each case with gender mainstreaming principles.
- Connect just transition strategies with further transformative climate action that tackles other societal inequalities simultaneously and in coordination.
