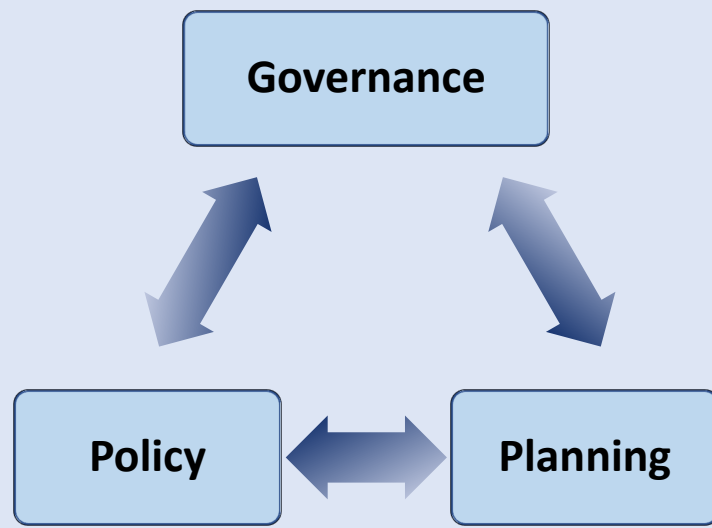


# Global Progress and Results from the Climate Promise: Gender Integration in NDCs

The Climate Promise is the world's largest offer of support for countries to enhance their pledges (NDCs) under the Paris Agreement.

Active in 120 countries, the Climate Promise facilitates countries to be bolder in reducing emissions, increasing resilience, committing to inclusivity, and protecting nature.

## UNDP's Approach to gender-responsive climate action



Countries have achieved **key gender integration milestones** across governance, policy and planning.

These results are building the **institutional capacity and systems** to implement and monitor gender-responsive climate action



64% of countries undertook **consultations** with women/women's groups



28% of countries have included **national gender institutions** as part of high-level NDC coordination



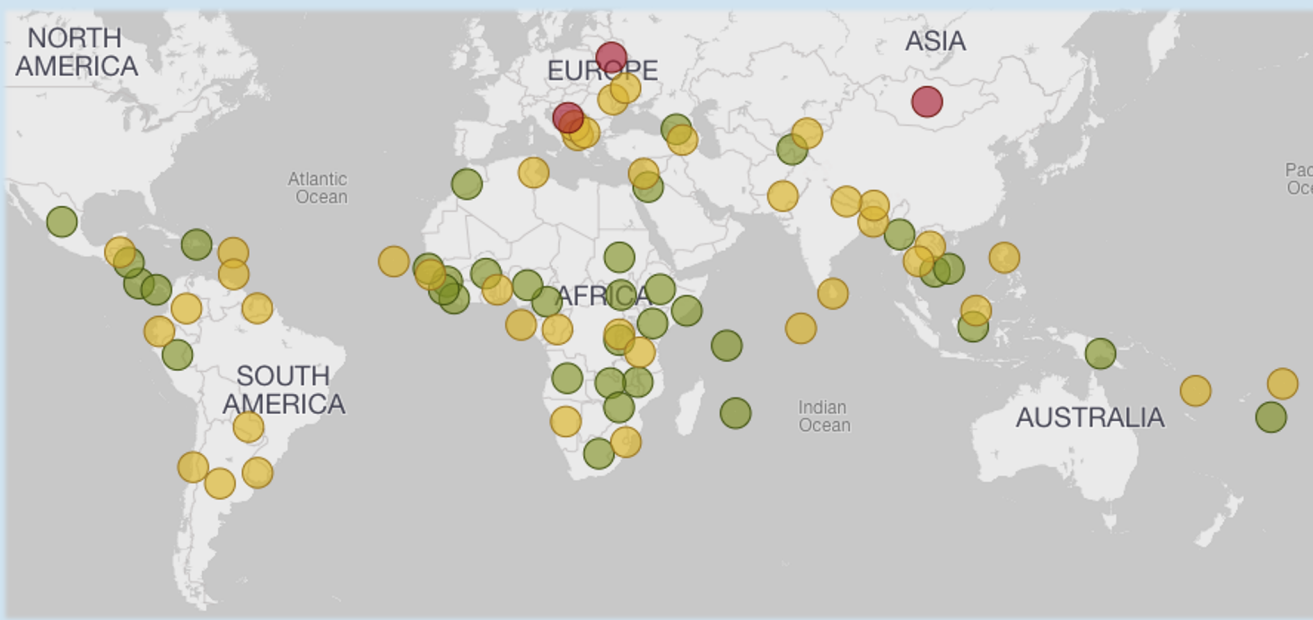
30% of countries strengthened **gender mainstreaming** in planning processes

## 76 out of 79 submitted NDCs from Climate Promise countries include gender/women



● **36 countries** Gender integrated in 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> NDC  
 ● **40 countries** Gender integrated in 2<sup>nd</sup> NDC  
 ● **3 countries** Gender NOT integrated in NDC

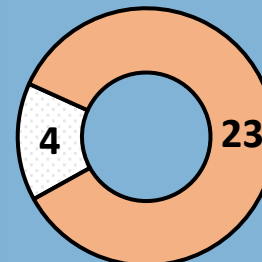

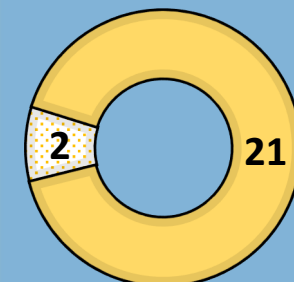
national equality policies recognized as part of climate policy framework

### GOVERNANCE

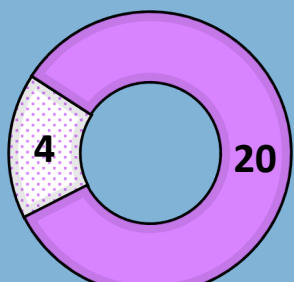
NDC recognizes the equal participation of women, including in decision-making around climate action

NDC calls for MRV to include gender considerations



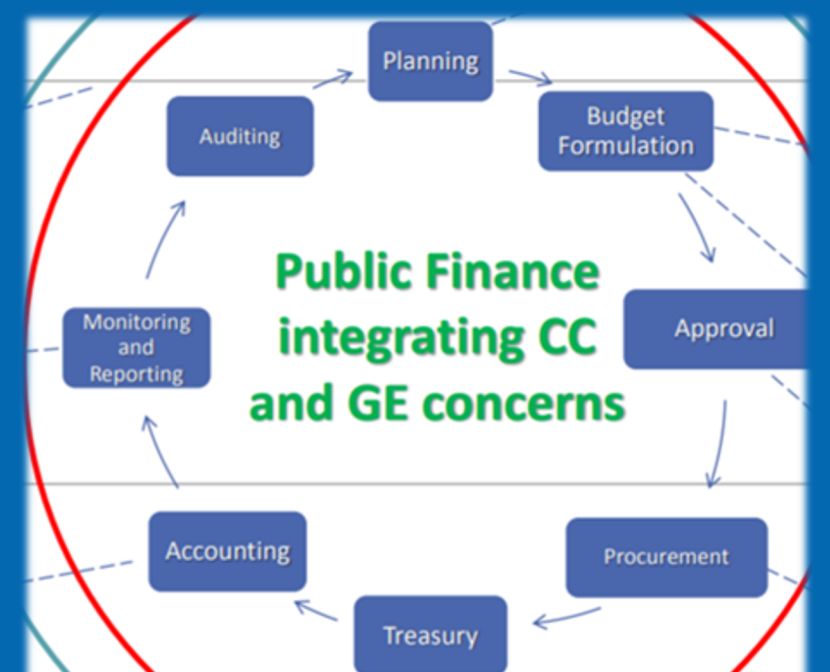
**CAMBODIA'S** NDC indicates the MRV can **track the gender sensitive impact** of climate action and effectiveness of gender mainstreaming if **appropriate indicators are embedded** in M&E frameworks. NDC highlights importance of **sex-disaggregated data** and proposes numerous gender indicators across adaptation sectors.

- Top Priorities:**
- National and sub-national budget processes increasingly formulate gender-responsive climate change related investments to have a positive impact on gender equality, poverty and human rights
  - Accountability for gender responsive-climate and inclusive climate change investments is strengthened
  - Regional institutions promote integrated and socially inclusive approaches to climate finance and budgeting, climate policies, plans and strategies
  - International policy processes give increasing priority to strengthen domestic budget systems that enable delivery of gender-responsive climate change investments
