WHAT

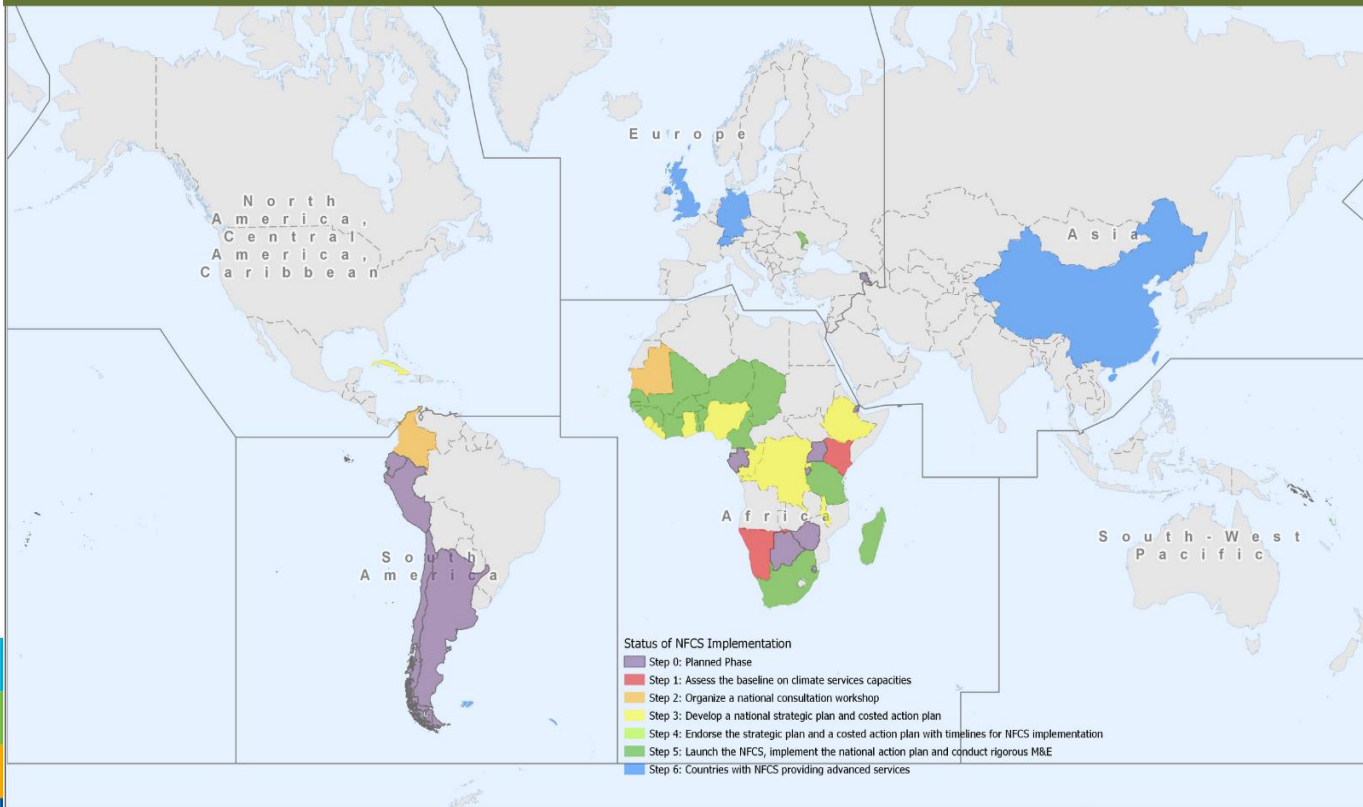
A mechanism for coordinating, facilitating and strengthening collaboration among national institutions and stakeholders.

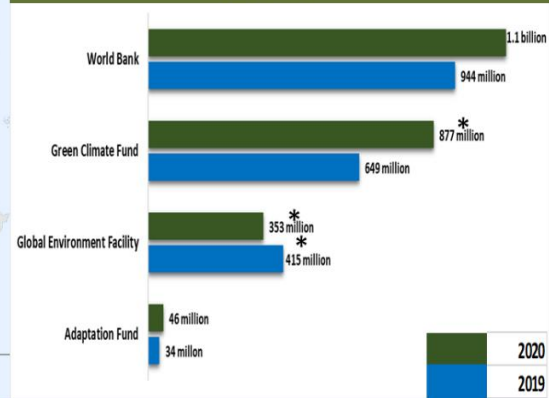
WHO
