

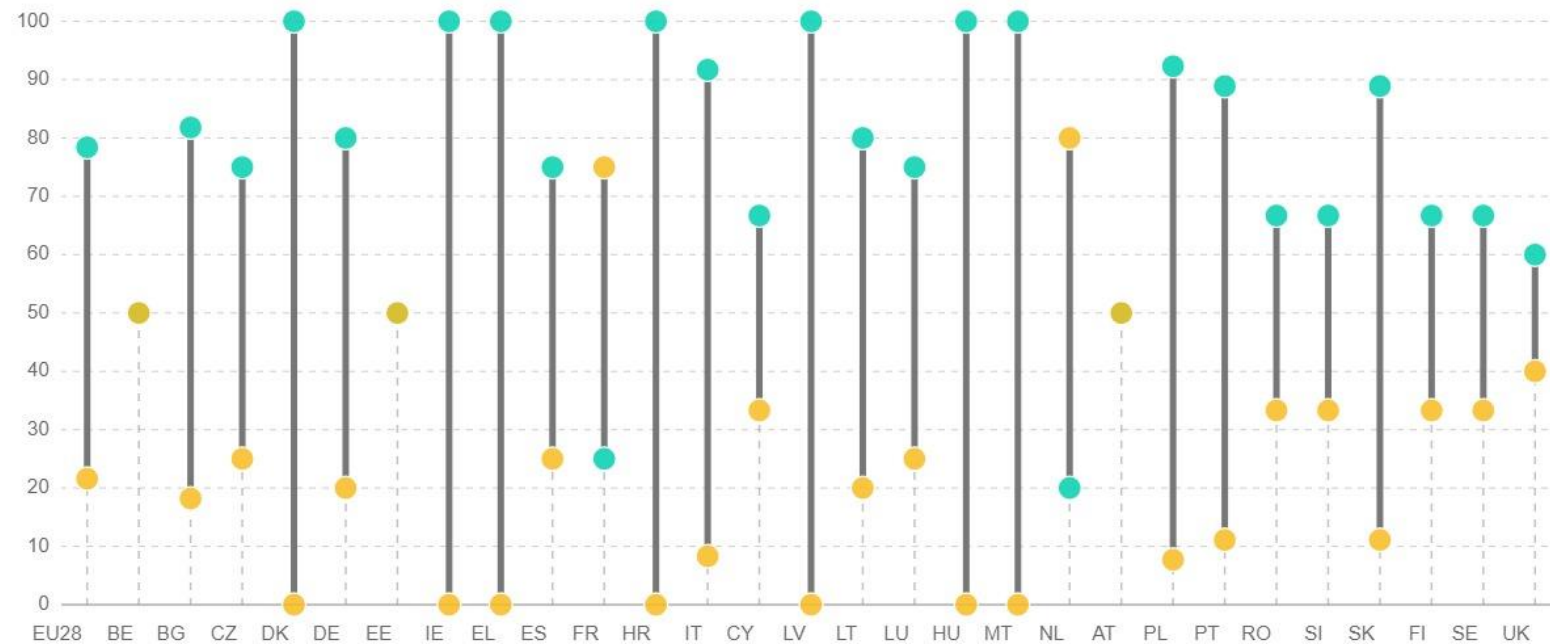

Example gaps in gender statistics

Lack of gender disaggregated data on employment and decision-making in the **renewable energy sector**

Need to collect data on **gender impacts of new technological solutions**, such as smart homes
