



NDCs 3.0 Partners Meeting

Support for Nationally Determined Contributions for Latin American countries

Date and Time: April 19, 2024, 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (Panama time)

Background

NDCs 3.0 for the year 2025 should be prepared with an implementation timeframe leading up to 2035. All Parties are required to submit their NDC 3.0 no later than February 2025, to allow sufficient time for the preparation of the compilation and synthesis report prior to CMA7 (November 2025). NDCs 3.0 are expected to be a progression beyond previous NDCs and reflect the highest possible ambition.

NDCs 3.0 will largely determine whether the world will return to a global GHG emissions trajectory that is in line with the Paris Agreement's 1.5°C temperature target and whether countries will build resilience to such a scenario. Ideally, the next NDCs should not only be ambitious in terms of numbers on paper. They should also help accelerate implementation, unlock finance and be well positioned to credibly move the needle on climate action.

With this in mind, the UNFCCC Secretariat plans to coordinate with key partners to ensure coordinated support to Parties to submit the NDCs 2025. To launch this effort, the Executive Secretary of the UNFCCC secretariat is convening a meeting to bring together key organizations to lay the groundwork to ensure that the NDCs 3.0 are adequate, accelerate implementation of climate action, unlock finance and are well positioned to credibly move the needle on climate action.

Objectives of the meeting:

Provide an opportunity for regional development and implementation partners to discuss approaches to increase cooperation and coordination in the provision of support for the development of ambitious and implementable NDCs by 2025 as next steps to the webinar that was held on Monday, March 25, 2024, which can be found on the official UNFCCC RCC LatAm webpage at the following link: <u>https://unfccc.int/event/support-ecosystem-for-next-round-of-ndcs-in-latin-america</u>

- Establishing shared knowledge about the current support provided by development organizations to countries in the LatAm region regarding the preparation and implementation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs).
- Identifying areas where the portfolios and initiatives of development organizations can synergize and complement each other in the realm of NDCs,





with the aim of enhancing implementation effectiveness at the national level, including engaging with the United Nations system.

• Collaborating on efforts, initiatives, and activities aimed at strengthening support for NDCs in the LatAm region, leveraging the collective expertise of development partners in the region and considering regional priorities and context
