To be an ENZI, a net zero initiative must:

1) Provide a 1.5°C-aligned signatory criteria verified by an independent expert group and disclosed on NAZCA

The Exponential Roadmap Initiative confirms that the Expert Peer Review Group of Race to Zero has reviewed the Initiative's criteria for its signatories.

2) Publish a Statement of Alignment with the UNSG High-Level Expert Group, disclosed on NAZCA

The Exponential Roadmap Initiative confirms that this statement of alignment will be published on our company website, and be publicly disclosed on NAZCA.

3) Meet the ethical requirements of the UNFCCC

The Exponential Roadmap Initiative confirms that it meets the ethical requirements of the UNFCCC, as stated [here](#).

4) Report annually on progress in line with CCI tracking requirements

The Exponential Roadmap Initiative confirms that our progress, as an initiative, will be reported annually according to the CCI annual progress tracking.
