**Eunjoo Park-Minc** 

Chief Advisor, Head of Sustainable Finance, Banco de Oro



Eunjoo Park-Minc is the Chief Advisor and concurrently Head of Sustainable Finance at Banco de Oro (BDO) in Manila, Philippines, since 2012. She has worked in the Financial Sector for more than 25 years as Financial Analyst, Professor of Finance and Green Finance Specialist. Currently she manages BDO's US\$ 4 billion Sustainable Finance portfolio, including of 54 RE projects and other climate action projects. She has led BDO to mobilize Php 548 billion into climate action projects under Sustainable Finance program. She has initiated BDO-wide sustainability strategies and sustainable finance with strong motivation. She is BDO's

steering committee for Transitional Plan to Sustainability. She established Sustainable Finance Framework for BDO, achieving strategic resilience by incorporating sustainability in the way the bank conducts its business, which was certified by Sustainalytics.

She led the issuance of the green bond, and the blue bond, the first innovative leveraged financial instruments to BDO, impacting Philippines' financial market as well as the regional market. BDO's green bond issuance of US\$ 150 million and blue bond issuance of US\$100 million, both invested by IFC, were truly the prolific result of the successful Sustainable Finance program. BDO's green bond in 2018 became the first for the banking industry in the Philippines and ASEAN region. Blue bond in 2022 is the first blue bond in the Philippines.

Ms. Park-Minc holds an MBA in International Business and Finance from George Washington University, Washington D.C. USA., a BA in Linguistics from Seoul National University, Seoul, South Korea. She is expecting an MSc in Green Energy and Climate Finance from Berlin School of Economics and Law, Berlin, Germany in 2022. She is a Certified Green Finance Specialist and Trainer by the Renewable Energy Academy (RENAC) in Berlin, Germany.
