What are the Warsaw International Mechanism and its Executive Committee?

The Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage

To address loss and damage associated with impacts of climate change, including extreme events and slow onset events, in developing countries that are particularly vulnerable to the adverse effects of climate change (Decision 2/CP.19)

Three functions:

- Enhancing understanding
- Enhancing dialogue, coordination, coherence, synergies
- Enhancing action and support

The Executive Committee

Guides the implementation of the functions of the Mechanism

Composed of 20 members

Expert groups, technical panels, etc. To help execute the work of the Executive Committee
