Linkages with Long-Term Global Goal

- Long Term Global Goal will have significant implications vis-à-vis achieving our collective climate change ambitions
- Warsaw International Mechanism and its Executive Committee established at COP 19
- Enhancing cooperation and facilitation for implementing approaches to averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage associated with climate change impacts, in particular in relation to slow onset event; non-economic losses, comprehensive risk management, human mobility, and action & support



- Work of the Executive Committee and its technical expert groups contribute to enhancing understanding of emerging climate-related risks
 - Task Force on Displacement and the Technical Expert Group on Comprehensive Risk Management previously established
 - In progress: launching of expert groups on slow onset events, noneconomic losses and action and support
- The best available science should inform approaches to averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage associated with climate change impacts
