



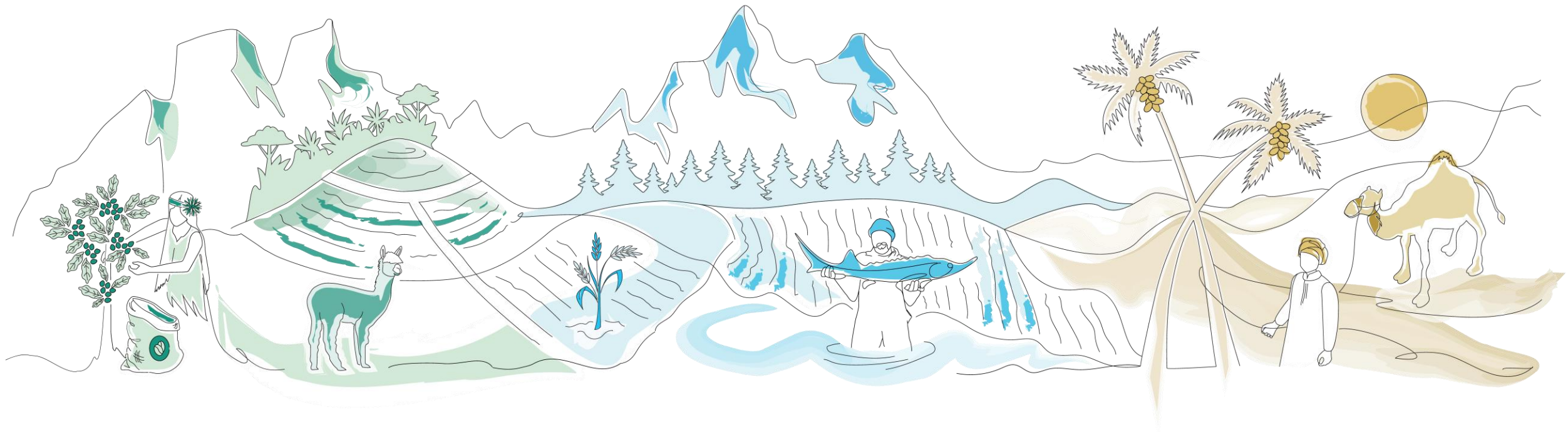

## CHALLENGES & LESSONS LEARNED

### INSTITUTIONAL CHALLENGES

Weak & fragmented institutional arrangements

Agrifood data gaps: discontinuous collection pipelines feeding into climate strategies

Difficulty identifying executing agencies with financial management capacity to implement projects

### TECHNICAL CHALLENGES

Persistent capacity gaps in ETF reporting requirements & improvement planning

Underutilization of available reporting tools & guidance frameworks

High staff turnover
