

The FACE-NDC project will strengthen the capacities of the energy, forestry, agriculture and education sectors to develop integrated and cross-sectoral behaviourally informed capacity-building and educational programmes. It will improve the capacities of students, teachers, professionals, government and private actors, and communities to adopt climate-friendly behaviors and contribute to a sustainable green transition. The project, running from 2023 to 2030, will empower society to achieve the Nationally Determined Contributions through three critical activities:

Development of context specific climate change education materials and curricula tailored for primary and secondary schools, universities, and vocational colleges.

Support for institutional and human capacity building to facilitate a green transition.

Strengthening non-formal education clubs and civil society organizations to reach vulnerable and groups, ensuring women and youth have a voice in the country's development trajectory.
