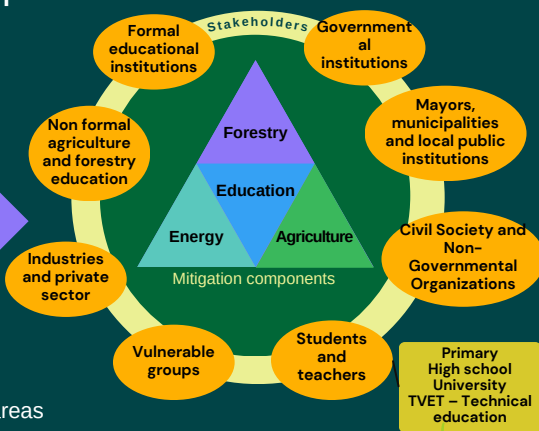
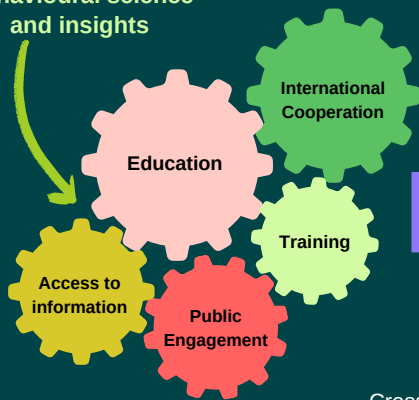
Development of context specific climate change education materials and curricula tailored for primary and secondary schools, universities, and vocational colleges.
